# **Conjugate Avert**

### **Avert in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I avert	We <b>avert</b>
You <b>avert</b>	You <b>avert</b>
He/She/It averts	They avert

### **Avert in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am averting	We are averting
You <b>are averting</b>	You <b>are averting</b>
He/She/It is averting	They are averting

#### **Avert in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have averted	We have averted
You have averted	You have averted
He/She/It has averted	They have averted

### **Avert in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been averting	We have been averting
You <b>have been averting</b>	You have been averting
He/She/It has been averting	They have been averting

### Avert in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I averted	We <b>averted</b>
You <b>averted</b>	You <b>averted</b>
He/She/It averted	They <b>averted</b>

### Avert in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was averting	We were averting
You were averting	You were averting
He/She/It was averting	They were averting

#### **Avert in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had averted	We had averted
You had averted	You had averted
He/She/It had averted	They had averted

### **Avert in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been averting	We had been averting
You <b>had been averting</b>	You had been averting
He/She/It had been averting	They had been averting

### Avert in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will avert	We <b>will avert</b>
You <b>will avert</b>	You <b>will avert</b>
He/She/It will avert	They will avert

### Avert in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be averting	We will be averting
You will be averting	You will be averting
He/She/It will be averting	They will be averting

Singular	Plural
I will have been averting	We <b>will have been averting</b>
