<a href="#">amaze</a>	Affect with wonder. <i>She <b>amazed</b> doctors by fighting back when her deteriorating condition caused her to suffer heart failure.</i>
<a href="#">amazement</a>	The feeling that accompanies something extremely surprising. <i>She shook her head in <b>amazement</b>.</i>
<b>astonishment</b>	The feeling that accompanies something extremely surprising. <i>She looked at him in <b>astonishment</b>.</i>
<a href="#">bewilderment</a>	A feeling of being perplexed and confused. <i>The three of them looked at him in <b>bewilderment</b>.</i>
<a href="#">blissful</a>	Extremely happy; full of joy. <i>The <b>blissful</b> caress of cool cotton sheets.</i>
<b>catalyst</b>	A substance that initiates or accelerates a chemical reaction without itself being affected. <i>The invasion acted as a <b>catalyst</b> to unite the country.</i>
<b>challenging</b>	Stimulating interest or thought. <i>There was a <b>challenging</b> glint in his eyes.</i>
<a href="#">cheer</a>	Cause somebody to feel happier or more cheerful. <i>MPs rose to <b>cheer</b> the Chancellor.</i>
<a href="#">dread</a>	A person with dreadlocks. <i>Flocks of wood sandpiper often excitable noisy and given to <b>dreads</b>.</i>
<b>encourage</b>	Persuade (someone) to do or continue to do something by giving support and advice. <i>Pupils are <b>encouraged</b> to be creative.</i>
<a href="#">entertaining</a>	Providing amusement or enjoyment. <i>A charming and <b>entertaining</b> companion.</i>
<b>esteem</b>	The condition of being honored esteemed or respected or well regarded. <i>He was held in high <b>esteem</b> by colleagues.</i>

<b>exciting</b>	Causing great enthusiasm and eagerness. <i>An <b>exciting</b> account of her trip.</i>
<b><u>exclamation</u></b>	An abrupt excited utterance. <i>An <b>exclamation</b> of amazement.</i>
<b><u>exhilarating</u></b>	Making lively and cheerful. <i>The <b>exhilarating</b> effect of mountain air.</i>
<b>gasp</b>	Strain to obtain air by gasping. <i>His breath was coming in <b>gasps</b>.</i>
<b><u>invigorating</u></b>	Imparting strength and vitality. <i>The <b>invigorating</b> mountain air.</i>
<b><u>motivational</u></b>	Relating to the reason or reasons for acting or behaving in a particular way. <i>Fear is used as a <b>motivational</b> tool.</i>
<b>mystification</b>	The activity of obscuring people's understanding, leaving them baffled or bewildered.
<b>piquant</b>	Pleasantly stimulating or exciting to the mind. <i>A <b>piquant</b> face with large appealing eyes.</i>
<b>provocation</b>	Needed encouragement. <i>The assault had taken place under <b>provocation</b>.</i>
<b><u>raunchy</u></b>	Energetically earthy and sexually explicit. <i>His <b>raunchy</b> new novel.</i>
<b>rousing</b>	Capable of arousing enthusiasm or excitement. <i>A <b>rousing</b> sermon.</i>
<b><u>sensational</u></b>	Very good indeed; very impressive or attractive. <i>A <b>sensational</b> view.</i>
<b>stimulating</b>	That stimulates. <i>A rich and <b>stimulating</b> working environment.</i>
<b><u>stimulus</u></b>	Any stimulating information or event; acts to arouse action. <i>If the tax were abolished it would act as a <b>stimulus</b> to exports.</i>
<b><u>stirring</u></b>	Exciting strong but not unpleasant emotions. <i><b>Stirring</b> events such as wars and rescues.</i>
<b>surprise</b>	Cause to be surprised. <i>He <b>surprised</b> a gang stealing scrap metal.</i>
<b><u>thrilling</u></b>	Causing quivering or shivering as by cold or fear or electric shock. <i>A <b>thrilling</b> performer to watch.</i>
<b>wonder</b>	Something that causes feelings of wonder. <i>How many times have I written that I <b>wonder</b>.</i>
