amaze	Affect with wonder. <i>She amazed doctors by fighting back when her deteriorating condition caused her to suffer heart failure.</i>
amazement	The feeling that accompanies something extremely surprising. <i>She shook her head in amazement.</i>
astonishment	The feeling that accompanies something extremely surprising. <i>She looked at him in astonishment.</i>
bewilderment	A feeling of being perplexed and confused. <i>The three of them looked at him in bewilderment.</i>
blissful	Extremely happy; full of joy. <i>The blissful caress of cool cotton sheets.</i>
catalyst	A substance that initiates or accelerates a chemical reaction without itself being affected. <i>The invasion acted as a catalyst to unite the country.</i>
challenging	Stimulating interest or thought. <i>There was a challenging glint in his eyes.</i>
cheer	Cause somebody to feel happier or more cheerful. <i>MPs rose to cheer the Chancellor.</i>
dread	A person with dreadlocks. <i>Flocks of wood sandpiper often excitable noisy and given to dreads.</i>
encourage	Persuade (someone) to do or continue to do something by giving support and advice. <i>Pupils are encouraged to be creative.</i>
entertaining	Providing amusement or enjoyment. <i>A charming and entertaining companion.</i>
esteem	The condition of being honored esteemed or respected or well regarded. <i>He was held in high esteem by colleagues.</i>

exciting	Causing great enthusiasm and eagerness. <i>An exciting account of her trip.</i>
<u>exclamation</u>	An abrupt excited utterance. <i>An exclamation of amazement.</i>
<u>exhilarating</u>	Making lively and cheerful. <i>The exhilarating effect of mountain air.</i>
gasp	Strain to obtain air by gasping. <i>His breath was coming in gasps.</i>
<u>invigorating</u>	Imparting strength and vitality. <i>The invigorating mountain air.</i>
<u>motivational</u>	Relating to the reason or reasons for acting or behaving in a particular way. <i>Fear is used as a motivational tool.</i>
mystification	The activity of obscuring people's understanding, leaving them baffled or bewildered.
piquant	Pleasantly stimulating or exciting to the mind. <i>A piquant face with large appealing eyes.</i>
provocation	Needed encouragement. <i>The assault had taken place under provocation.</i>
<u>raunchy</u>	Energetically earthy and sexually explicit. <i>His raunchy new novel.</i>
rousing	Capable of arousing enthusiasm or excitement. <i>A rousing sermon.</i>
<u>sensational</u>	Very good indeed; very impressive or attractive. <i>A sensational view.</i>
stimulating	That stimulates. <i>A rich and stimulating working environment.</i>
<u>stimulus</u>	Any stimulating information or event; acts to arouse action. <i>If the tax were abolished it would act as a stimulus to exports.</i>
<u>stirring</u>	Exciting strong but not unpleasant emotions. <i>Stirring events such as wars and rescues.</i>
surprise	Cause to be surprised. <i>He surprised a gang stealing scrap metal.</i>
<u>thrilling</u>	Causing quivering or shivering as by cold or fear or electric shock. <i>A thrilling performer to watch.</i>
wonder	Something that causes feelings of wonder. <i>How many times have I written that I wonder.</i>
