- *An affectionate form of address, typically for someone with whom one has a sexual or romantic relationship.*
- *A baby.*
- *A very young child (birth to 1 year) who has not yet begun to walk or talk.*
- *A sexually attractive young woman.*

- babe in arms** A state in midwestern United States.
- baby** A thing regarded with affection or familiarity.
*Don't be such a **baby** she said witheringly.*
- child** An immature childish person.
*The **children** of Israel.*
- darling** A special loved one.
*Good night **darling**.*
- dear** A beloved person used as terms of endearment.
*Harry is a **dear**.*
- dearest** A sweet innocent mild-mannered person (especially a child).
*You make me so happy **dearest**.*
- infant** Denoting something in an early stage of its development.
*Their first year at **infant** school.*
- little one** A small amount or duration.

newborn A recently born child or animal.
*She s incapable of looking after a **newborn**.*

sweetheart Denoting an arrangement or agreement reached privately by two sides in an unofficial or illicit way.
*Don t worry **sweetheart** I ve got it all worked out.*

tot A young child.
*A **tot** of brandy.*



Usage Examples of "Babe" as a noun

- *It was the best day of my life—except for meeting you, babe.*
- *He's been pumping up his pecs to impress the babes.*
- *Hey babes, I know it is unscrupulous and underhand, but don't blame me!*
- *I wish you weren't quite such a babe.*
- *You have a babe, who will surely be treated as a king when he grows.*
