
Babysitter as a Noun

Definitions of "Babysitter" as a noun

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "babysitter" as a noun can have the following definitions:

- A person who looks after a child or children while the parents are out.
- A person engaged to care for children when the parents are not home.







Synonyms of "Babysitter" as a noun (2 Words)

baby-sitter A person engaged to care for children when the parents are not home.

sitter An organism (person or animal) that sits. Sitters in an examination room.

Usage Examples of "Babysitter" as a noun

- *He couldn't find a babysitter.*
- Natalie had worked for her as a babysitter.
