## Associations of "Back and forth" (30 Words)

<b><u>anachronism</u></b>	Something located at a time when it could not have existed or occurred. <i>It is <b>anachronism</b> to suppose that the official morality of the age was mere window dressing.</i>
<b>backslide</b>	Drop to a lower level, as in one’s morals or standards. <i>There are many things that can cause slimmers to <b>backslide</b>.</i>
<b>backward</b>	(of a fielding position) behind an imaginary line passing through the stumps at the batsman’s end at right angles to the wicket. <i><b>Backward</b> square leg.</i>
<b>backwards</b>	In reverse of the usual direction or order. <i>Count <b>backwards</b> from twenty to ten.</i>
<b>behind</b>	A kick that sends the ball over a behind line or a touch that sends it between the inner posts scoring one point. <i>She slid inelegantly down a few steps on her <b>behind</b>.</i>
<b>degeneracy</b>	Moral perversion; impairment of virtue and moral principles. <i>A slide into moral <b>degeneracy</b>.</i>
<b>degeneration</b>	Passing from a more complex to a simpler biological form. <i>Overgrazing has caused serious <b>degeneration</b> of grassland.</i>
<b>discontinuity</b>	A break in or lack of continuity. <i>There is no significant <b>discontinuity</b> between modern and primitive societies.</i>
<b>inverse</b>	Opposite or contrary in position, direction, order, or effect. <i><b>Inverse</b> logarithms.</i>
<b>later</b>	At some eventual time in the future. <i>A <b>later</b> symptom of the disease.</i>
<b>past</b>	A verb tense that expresses actions or states in the past. <i>The <b>past</b> year.</i>

<b>posterior</b>	Relating to or denoting presentation of a fetus in which the rear or caudal end is nearest the cervix and emerges first at birth. <i>The <b>posterior</b> part of the gut.</i>
<b>posthumous</b>	Occurring or coming into existence after a person's death. <i>He was awarded a <b>posthumous</b> Military Cross.</i>
<u><a href="#">regress</a></u>	Calculate the coefficient or coefficients of regression of a variable against or on another variable. <i>They would not <b>regress</b> to pre technological tribalism.</i>
<u><a href="#">regression</a></u>	A lessening of the severity of a disease or its symptoms. <i>It is easy to blame unrest on economic <b>regression</b>.</i>
<b>regressive</b>	Relating to or marked by psychological regression. <i><b>Regressive</b> aspects of recent local government reform.</i>
<u><a href="#">relapse</a></u>	A failure to maintain a higher state. <i>He responded well to treatment but then suffered a <b>relapse</b>.</i>
<b>restoration</b>	The restoration of the Bourbon monarchy in France in 1814 following the fall of Napoleon Louis XVIII was recalled from exile by Talleyrand. <i>Published <b>restorations</b> are dodgy based on single bones.</i>
<b>retrace</b>	Trace (something) back to its source or beginning. <i>He began to <b>retrace</b> his steps to the station car park.</i>
<b>retreat</b>	Make a retreat from an earlier commitment or activity. <i>It becomes so hot that the lizards <b>retreat</b> into the shade.</i>
<u><a href="#">retroactive</a></u>	Affecting things past. <i><b>Retroactive</b> tax increase.</i>
<b>retrograde</b>	Show retrograde motion. <i>A <b>retrograde</b> flow.</i>
<b>retrogression</b>	The process of returning to an earlier state, typically a worse one. <i>A <b>retrogression</b> to 19th century attitudes.</i>
<u><a href="#">retrospect</a></u>	Look back upon (a period of time, sequence of events); remember. <i>In <b>retrospect</b>.</i>
<b>retrospective</b>	Concerned with or related to the past. <i>Our survey was <b>retrospective</b>.</i>
<b>return</b>	A returning officer's announcement of an election result. <i>A <b>return</b> flight.</i>
<b>reversion</b>	A property to which someone has the right of reversion. <i>He was given a promise of the <b>reversion</b> of Boraston's job.</i>
<u><a href="#">revert</a></u>	Reply or respond to someone. <i>We texted both Farah and Shirish but neither of them <b>reverted</b>.</i>

**throwback**

A reversion to an earlier ancestral characteristic.

*A lot of his work is a **throwback** to the fifties.*

**ventral**

Toward or on or near the belly (front of a primate or lower surface of a lower animal).

***Ventral** or pelvic fins correspond to the hind limbs of a quadruped.*
