mountain (often followed by `of') a large number or amount or extent.

The yarn (as in a rug or velvet or corduroy) that stands up from the weave.

Tottering **pile**s of dirty dishes.

A district that is reserved for particular purpose.

Australia has major coal gas and uranium **reserve**s.

stockpile Something kept back or saved for future use or a special purpose.

A **stockpile** of nuclear weapons.
