Backlog as a Noun

Definitions of "Backlog" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “backlog” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *Something kept back or saved for future use or a special purpose.*
- *The large log at the back of a hearth fire.*
- *An accumulation of uncompleted work or matters needing to be dealt with.*
- *An accumulation of jobs not done or materials not processed that are yet to be dealt with (especially unfilled customer orders for products or services).*



Synonyms of "Backlog" as a noun (8 Words)

accumulation	The acquisition or gradual gathering of something. <i>The accumulation of paperwork on her desk.</i>
excess	Excessive indulgence. <i>Bouts of alcoholic excess.</i>
heap	An amount of a particular loose substance. <i>Her clothes lay in a heap on the floor.</i>
logjam	A backlog. <i>The president can use his power to break the logjam over this issue.</i>
mountain	(often followed by `of') a large number or amount or extent. <i>We set off down the mountain.</i>
pile	The yarn (as in a rug or velvet or corduroy) that stands up from the weave. <i>Tottering piles of dirty dishes.</i>
reserve	A district that is reserved for particular purpose. <i>Australia has major coal gas and uranium reserves.</i>
stockpile	Something kept back or saved for future use or a special purpose. <i>A stockpile of nuclear weapons.</i>
