Infinitive	<b>to backstroke</b>
Present Tense	<b>backstroke / backstrokes</b>
Past Tense	<b>backstroked</b>
Present Participle	<b>backstroking</b>
Past Participle	<b>backstroked</b>

## Conjugate Backstroke

**Backstroke in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>backstroke</b>	We <b>backstroke</b>
You <b>backstroke</b>	You <b>backstroke</b>
He/She/It <b>backstrokes</b>	They <b>backstroke</b>

## **Backstroke in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am backstroking</b>	We <b>are backstroking</b>
You <b>are backstroking</b>	You <b>are backstroking</b>
He/She/It <b>is backstroking</b>	They <b>are backstroking</b>

## **Backstroke in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have backstroked</b>	We <b>have backstroked</b>
You <b>have backstroked</b>	You <b>have backstroked</b>
He/She/It <b>has backstroked</b>	They <b>have backstroked</b>

## **Backstroke in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have been backstroking</b>	We <b>have been backstroking</b>
You <b>have been backstroking</b>	You <b>have been backstroking</b>
He/She/It <b>has been backstroking</b>	They <b>have been backstroking</b>

## **Backstroke in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>backstroked</b>	We <b>backstroked</b>
You <b>backstroked</b>	You <b>backstroked</b>
He/She/It <b>backstroked</b>	They <b>backstroked</b>

## **Backstroke in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was backstroking      We were backstroking  
You were backstroking      You were backstroking  
He/She/It was backstroking      They were backstroking

**Backstroke in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had backstroked      We had backstroked  
You had backstroked      You had backstroked  
He/She/It had backstroked      They had backstroked

**Backstroke in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been backstroking      We had been backstroking  
You had been backstroking      You had been backstroking  
He/She/It had been backstroking      They had been backstroking

**Backstroke in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will backstroke      We will backstroke  
You will backstroke      You will backstroke  
He/She/It will backstroke      They will backstroke

**Backstroke in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

I will be backstroking      We will be backstroking  
You will be backstroking      You will be backstroking  
He/She/It will be backstroking      They will be backstroking

**We will have backstroked**

**You will have backstroked**

**You will have backstroked**

**He/She/It will have backstroked** **They will have backstroked**
