ceiling	Maximum altitude at which a plane can fly (under specified conditions). <i>The aircraft s quoted ceiling of 24 000 feet.</i>

domesticity	Home or family life. <i>The atmosphere is one of happy domesticity.</i>
dwelling	Housing that someone is living in. <i>The proposed dwelling is out of keeping with those nearby.</i>
estate	A class or order regarded as forming part of the body politic in particular in Britain one of the three groups constituting Parliament now the Lords spiritual the heads of the Church the Lords temporal the peerage and the Commons They are also known as the three estates. <i>Lucy and Tony live on an estate in West London.</i>
fence	Enclose with a fence. <i>After stealing your ring he didn t even know how to fence it.</i>
garden	Work in the garden. <i>It is a common or garden sparrow.</i>
habitat	A person’s usual or preferred surroundings. <i>A marine habitat.</i>
hallway	An interior passage or corridor onto which rooms open.
hedge	Hinder or restrict with or as if with a hedge. <i>The company hedged its investment position on the futures market.</i>

homestead	Settle land given by the government and occupy it as a homestead.
house	The people living in a house a household. A house of 45 boarders.
housing	A protective cover designed to contain or support a mechanical component. A housing association.
hut	Provide with huts. A beach hut .
lodging	The act of lodging. He was looking for lodgings and a job.
manor	The landed estate of a lord (including the house on it). The right to mine ores within the manor of Little Langdale.
mansion	A terrace or mansion block. Carlyle Mansions .
mews	A group of stables, typically with rooms above, built round a yard or along an alley. She lives in a Chelsea mews .
patio	A roofless inner courtyard in a Spanish or Spanish American house. The dining room looks out to a small patio .
residence	A person's home, especially a large and impressive one. The youth hostel has been adapted from a private residence .
semi	A semi detached house. A three bedroomed semi .
sheltered	Protected from danger or bad weather. I was a mathematics don at Cambridge living a rather sheltered life.
tenement	Any kind of permanent property, e.g. lands or rents, held from a superior.
tepee	A portable conical tent made of skins, cloth, or canvas on a frame of poles, used by North American Indians of the Plains and Great Lakes regions.
terrace	Provide a house with a terrace. The slope had to be terraced .
toga	A one-piece cloak worn by men in ancient Rome.
treetop	The uppermost part of a tree.
watering	Shedding tears. The lawn needs a great deal of watering .
