Synonyms of "Badlands" as a noun (4 Words)

- bad lands** That which is below standard or expectations as of ethics or decency.
- uninhabited region** A part of an animal that has a special function or is supplied by a given artery or nerve.
- wastes** (law) reduction in the value of an estate caused by act or neglect.
*The trackless **wastes** of the desert.*
- wilds** A wild and uninhabited area left in its natural condition.
