area	A particular geographical region of indefinite boundary (usually serving some special purpose or distinguished by its people or culture or geography. <i>Rural areas of Britain.</i>
area of activity	A particular environment or walk of life.
<u>branch</u>	A part of a forked or branching shape. Botany is a branch of biology.
department	A specialized sphere of knowledge. <i>He was a bit lacking in the height department.</i>



<u>discipline</u>	A system of rules of conduct or method of practice. <i>For such a plan to work requires discipline.</i>
domain	The set of possible values of the independent variable or variables of a function. His domain extended into Europe.
<u>field</u>	A fielder. He planted a field of wheat.
field of study	A geographic region (land or sea) under which something valuable is found.
line	An arrangement of soldiers or ships in a column or line formation a line of battle. You must wait in a long line at the checkout counter.
<u>province</u>	An area of special knowledge, interest, or responsibility. I made my way home to the dreary province s by train.
<u>sector</u>	The minimum track length that can be assigned to store information unless otherwise specified a sector of data consists of 512 bytes. <i>He was helpless in an important</i> sector <i>of his life.</i>
specialism	The concentration of your efforts on a particular field of study or occupation. One of her areas of specialism is police reform.
<u>speciality</u>	An asset of special worth or utility. <i>Speciality</i> potatoes for salads.
specialization	The process of concentrating on and becoming expert in a particular subject or skill. The way different muscles are constructed allows for specialization of function.
specialty	An asset of special worth or utility.
sphere	The apparent surface of the imaginary sphere on which celestial bodies appear to be projected. <i>His social sphere is limited.</i>
study	A thing that is or deserves to be investigated the subject of an individual s study. He knocked lightly on the closed door of the study .
<u>subject</u>	The subject matter of a conversation or discussion. Subject s were asked to complete a questionnaire.
subject area	The subject matter of a conversation or discussion.
subject field	Some situation or event that is thought about.
