<u>barber</u>	Perform the services of a barber cut the hair and or beard of. <i>He had his hair cut at the local barber s.</i>
butcher	Kill (a person or people) indiscriminately or brutally. The film was butcher ed by the studio that released it.
cake	Baked goods made from or based on a mixture of flour, sugar, eggs, and fat. <i>The blood under his nose was beginning to cake</i> .
<u>candy</u>	Coat with something sweet, such as a hard sugar glaze. A candy bar.
<u>chef</u>	Work as a chef. He chef fed on a yacht in the Riviera for two years.
<u>cook</u>	A person who prepares and cooks food especially as a job or in a specified way. <i>I told you I could cook.</i>



cookery	The act of preparing something (as food) by the application of heat. People are needed who have experience in cookery .
corn	Whiskey distilled from a mash of not less than 80 percent corn. <i>Corn</i> ed beef.
<u>culinary</u>	Of or relating to or used in cooking. Savour the culinary delights of the region.
deli	A shop selling ready-to-eat food products.
fishmonger	Someone who sells fish.
flour	Cover with flour. <i>Flour</i> fish or meat before frying it.
furrier	Someone whose occupation is making or repairing fur garments. I came across a very classy furrier s in Nottingham.
goody	Something considered choice to eat.
grocer	A retail merchant who sells foodstuffs (and some household supplies.
grocery	Items of food sold in a grocery or supermarket. The grocery store included a meat market.
hairdresser	A person who cuts and styles hair as an occupation.
homemade	Made or produced in the home or by yourself. <i>Homemade</i> bread.
<u>market</u>	A marketplace where groceries are sold. They wanted to browse around the street market .
<u>marketplace</u>	The world of commercial activity where goods and services are bought and sold. <i>The quaint cobbled marketplace</i> .
<u>merchant</u>	In historical contexts relating to merchants or commerce. A merchant of death.
miller	Someone who works in a mill (especially a grain mill.
pastry	An item of food consisting of sweet pastry with a cream jam or fruit filling. <i>Spread the mixture over the pastry.</i>
<u>restaurant</u>	A place where people pay to sit and eat meals that are cooked and served on the premises.
sell	Sell all of one s property possessions or assets. The brothers sell shoes.
<u>seller</u>	A person who sells something. The book became the biggest seller in the history of royal publishing.



shop	Alter a photographic image digitally using Photoshop image editing software. <i>He bought it at a shop on Cape Cod.</i>
trader	Someone who purchases and maintains an inventory of goods to be sold.
<u>vendor</u>	The seller in a sale, especially of property. An Italian ice cream vendor .
wholesale	At a wholesale price. <i>Wholesale</i> destruction.
