Definitions of "Baker" as a noun

- *An oven used for a particular purpose.*
- *A person who makes bread and cakes, especially as a trade.*
- *Someone who bakes commercially.*
- *Someone who bakes bread or cake.*

bread maker Food made from dough of flour or meal and usually raised with yeast or baking powder and then baked.

- cook** A person who prepares and cooks food especially as a job or in a specified way.
*I told you I could **cook**.*

cookery	The act of preparing something (as food) by the application of heat. <i>People are needed who have experience in cookery.</i>
corn	Whiskey distilled from a mash of not less than 80 percent corn. <i>Corned beef.</i>
culinary	Of or relating to or used in cooking. <i>Savour the culinary delights of the region.</i>
deli	A shop selling ready-to-eat food products.
fishmonger	Someone who sells fish.
flour	Cover with flour. <i>Flour fish or meat before frying it.</i>
furrier	Someone whose occupation is making or repairing fur garments. <i>I came across a very classy furrier s in Nottingham.</i>
goody	Something considered choice to eat.
grocer	A retail merchant who sells foodstuffs (and some household supplies).
grocery	Items of food sold in a grocery or supermarket. <i>The grocery store included a meat market.</i>
hairdresser	A person who cuts and styles hair as an occupation.
homemade	Made or produced in the home or by yourself. <i>Homemade bread.</i>
market	A marketplace where groceries are sold. <i>They wanted to browse around the street market.</i>
marketplace	The world of commercial activity where goods and services are bought and sold. <i>The quaint cobbled marketplace.</i>
merchant	In historical contexts relating to merchants or commerce. <i>A merchant of death.</i>
miller	Someone who works in a mill (especially a grain mill).
pastry	An item of food consisting of sweet pastry with a cream jam or fruit filling. <i>Spread the mixture over the pastry.</i>
restaurant	A place where people pay to sit and eat meals that are cooked and served on the premises.
sell	Sell all of one s property possessions or assets. <i>The brothers sell shoes.</i>
seller	A person who sells something. <i>The book became the biggest seller in the history of royal publishing.</i>

- trader** Someone who purchases and maintains an inventory of goods to be sold.
- vendor** The seller in a sale, especially of property.
