# **Conjugate Balk**

## **Balk in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>balk</b>	We <b>balk</b>
You <b>balk</b>	You <b>balk</b>
He/She/It <b>balks</b>	They <b>balk</b>

## **Balk in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>am balking</b>	We <b>are balking</b>
You <b>are balking</b>	You <b>are balking</b>
He/She/It is balking	They are balking

#### **Balk in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have balked	We have balked
You have balked	You have balked
He/She/It has balked	They have balked

#### **Balk in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been balking	We have been balking
You <b>have been balking</b>	You have been balking
He/She/It has been balking	They have been balking

## **Balk in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>balked</b>	We <b>balked</b>
You <b>balked</b>	You <b>balked</b>
He/She/It <b>balked</b>	They <b>balked</b>

## **Balk in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was balking	We <b>were balking</b>
You <b>were balking</b>	You <b>were balking</b>
He/She/It was balking	They were balking

#### **Balk in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had balked	We had balked
You <b>had balked</b>	You had balked
He/She/It had balked	They had balked

### **Balk in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been balking	We had been balking
You <b>had been balking</b>	You had been balking
He/She/It had been balking	They had been balking

## **Balk in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>will balk</b>	We will balk
You <b>will balk</b>	You <b>will balk</b>
He/She/It will balk	They will balk

## **Balk in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be balking	We <b>will be balking</b>
You <b>will be balking</b>	You will be balking
He/She/It will be balking	They will be balking

#### **Balk in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have balkedWe will have balkedYou will have balkedYou will have balkedHe/She/It will have balkedThey will have balked

#### **Balk in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been balking	We <b>will have been balking</b>
You <b>will have been balking</b>	You <b>will have been balking</b>
He/She/It will have been balking	They will have been balking
