You ballpark You ballpark

He/She/It ballparks They ballpark

Ballpark in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am ballparking We are ballparking
You are ballparking You are ballparking
He/She/It is ballparking They are ballparking

Ballpark in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have ballparked We have ballparked
You have ballparked You have ballparked
He/She/It has ballparked They have ballparked

Ballpark in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been ballparking We have been ballparking
You have been ballparking You have been ballparking
He/She/It has been ballparking They have been ballparking

He/She/It had been ballparking They had been ballparking

I will ballpark
You will ballpark
He/She/It will ballpark
They will ballpark

Ballpark in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be ballparking
You will be ballparking
He/She/It will be ballparking
They will be ballparking

Ballpark in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

I will have been ballparking
You will have been ballparking
He/She/It will have been ballparking
They will have been ballparking
