Infinitive	<b>to barge</b>
Present Tense	<b>barge / barges</b>
Past Tense	<b>barged</b>
Present Participle	<b>barging</b>
Past Participle	<b>barged</b>

## Conjugate Barge

### Barge in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>barge</b>	We <b>barge</b>
You <b>barge</b>	You <b>barge</b>
He/She/It <b>bares</b>	They <b>barge</b>

## **Barge in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am barging</b>	We <b>are barging</b>
You <b>are barging</b>	You <b>are barging</b>
He/She/It <b>is barging</b>	They <b>are barging</b>

## **Barge in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have barged</b>	We <b>have barged</b>
You <b>have barged</b>	You <b>have barged</b>
He/She/It <b>has barged</b>	They <b>have barged</b>

## **Barge in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been barging</b>	We <b>have been barging</b>
You <b>have been barging</b>	You <b>have been barging</b>
He/She/It <b>has been barging</b>	They <b>have been barging</b>

## **Barge in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>barged</b>	We <b>barged</b>
You <b>barged</b>	You <b>barged</b>
He/She/It <b>barged</b>	They <b>barged</b>

## **Barge in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular****Plural**

<b>I was barging</b>	<b>We were barging</b>
<b>You were barging</b>	<b>You were barging</b>
<b>He/She/It was barging</b>	<b>They were barging</b>

**Barge in Past Perfect Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I had barged</b>	<b>We had barged</b>
<b>You had barged</b>	<b>You had barged</b>
<b>He/She/It had barged</b>	<b>They had barged</b>

**Barge in Past Perfect Continuous Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I had been barging</b>	<b>We had been barging</b>
<b>You had been barging</b>	<b>You had been barging</b>
<b>He/She/It had been barging</b>	<b>They had been barging</b>

**Barge in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I will barge</b>	<b>We will barge</b>
<b>You will barge</b>	<b>You will barge</b>
<b>He/She/It will barge</b>	<b>They will barge</b>

**Barge in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I will be barging</b>	<b>We will be barging</b>
<b>You will be barging</b>	<b>You will be barging</b>
<b>He/She/It will be barging</b>	<b>They will be barging</b>

**I will have barged**

**We will have barged**

**You will have barged**

**You will have barged**

**He/She/It will have barged**

**They will have barged**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been barging**

**We will have been barging**

**You will have been barging**

**You will have been barging**

**He/She/It will have been barging**

**They will have been barging**
