- knock** The sound of knocking as on a door or in an engine or bearing.  
*The region s industries have taken a severe **knock**.*

**smash** An act or sound of something smashing.  
A forearm **smash**.

## Synonyms of "Bashes" as a verb (5 Words)

**bonk** Hit or strike (someone or something).  
*He **bonked** his head on the plane's low bulkhead.*

**bop** Dance the bebop.  
*Everyone was **bopping** until the small hours.*

**sock** Hit forcefully.  
*Jess **socked** his father across the face.*

**whap** Hit hard.

**whop** Hit hard.  
*Smith **whopped** him on the nose.*
