spangled	Covered with beads or jewels or sequins. A fireworks display on the beach lit up the star spangled sky.

Associations of "Beady" (30 Words)

amber	A honey yellow colour typical of amber. Amber eyes.
amethyst	A precious stone consisting of a violet or purple variety of quartz. <i>An amethyst dress.</i>
beaded	Covered with beads of liquid. Beaded chiffon dresses.
bracelet	An ornamental band, hoop, or chain worn on the wrist or arm.
braid	Form or weave into a braid or braids. Their garments were braid ed with silk.



<u>brooch</u>	Fasten with or as if with a brooch.
calcite	A white or colourless mineral consisting of calcium carbonate. It is a major constituent of sedimentary rocks such as limestone and is deposited in caves to form stalactites and stalagmites.
<u>chain</u>	Confine with a chain. The action would initiate a chain of events.
circlet	A circular band, typically one made of precious metal, worn on the head as an ornament.
<u>crystal</u>	Clear and transparent like crystal. A collection of crystal .
dangle	Cause to dangle or hang freely. Saucepans dangle d from a rail.
<u>diamond</u>	A transparent piece of diamond that has been cut and polished and is valued as a precious gem. <i>Diamonds were trumps.</i>
earring	Jewelry to ornament the ear; usually clipped to the earlobe or fastened through a hole in the lobe.
<u>gem</u>	Decorate with or as with gems. Tiny drops of sweat gem med his forehead.
<u>glass</u>	A container made of glass for holding liquids while drinking. A glass door.
<u>gold</u>	Made of or coloured like gold. The gold dome of the Capitol.
granulate	Form into grains. We have the capacity to granulate 100 of the potash we produce.
jade	A semiprecious gemstone that takes a high polish is usually green but sometimes whitish consists of jadeite or nephrite. <i>A silk blouse in a vivid jade green.</i>
<u>jewelry</u>	An adornment (as a bracelet or ring or necklace) made of precious metals and set with gems (or imitation gems.
medallion	An oval or circular painting, panel, or design used to decorate a building or textile. Medallions of veal.
nacre	Mother-of-pearl.
necklace	In South Africa kill someone with a tyre necklace. A diamond necklace .



nephrite	A hard, pale green or white mineral which is one of the forms of jade. It is a silicate of calcium and magnesium.
ornament	Be an ornament to. Sense of humour is an ornament to character.
pearl	Something resembling a pearl. These things are pearl s amidst the everyday.
pendant	A necklace with a pendant. I slipped the pendant over my neck.
quartz	A hard glossy mineral consisting of silicon dioxide in crystal form present in most rocks especially sandstone and granite yellow sand is quartz with iron oxide impurities.
ring	A ring shaped or circular object. Through traffic is diverted along the outer ring .
turquoise	A blue to grey green mineral consisting of copper aluminum phosphate. <i>The turquoise</i> waters of the bay.
wampum	Informal terms for money. Strings of wampum .
