- The hair growing on the lower part of a man's face.
- A person who carries out a transaction, typically a bet, for someone else in order to conceal the other's identity.
- An animal's growth or marking that is likened to a beard, for example the gills of an oyster, or the beak bristles of certain birds.



- A tuft or growth of hairs or bristles on certain plants such as iris or grasses.
- Tuft of strong filaments by which e.g. a mussel makes itself fast to a fixed surface.
- A woman who accompanies a gay man as an escort to a social occasion, in order to help conceal his homosexuality.






