<b>dish</b>	A piece of dishware normally used as a container for holding or serving food. <i>I gather he s quite a <b>dish</b>.</i>
<b>knockout</b>	A very attractive or seductive looking woman. <i>A <b>knockout</b> blow.</i>
<b>looker</b>	A very attractive person. <i>A tough <b>looker</b> is not necessarily a tough fighter.</i>
<b>lulu</b>	An outstanding example of a particular type of person or thing. <i>As far as nightmares went this one was a <b>lulu</b>.</i>
<b>mantrap</b>	A trap for catching trespassers.
<b>peach</b>	A pinkish yellow colour like that of a peach. <i>The sky began to change from grey to <b>peach</b>.</i>
<b>ravisher</b>	A very attractive or seductive looking woman.

- smasher** A very attractive or seductive looking woman.  
*Riot police had clashed with window **smashers**.*
- stunner** An amazing turn of events.  
*The real **stunner** comes when the boy's father also blames her.*
- sweetheart** Any well-liked individual.  
*Don't worry **sweetheart** I've got it all worked out.*

- barber** Perform the services of a barber cut the hair and or beard of.  
*He had his hair cut at the local **barber**s.*
- beautiful** Delighting the senses or exciting intellectual or emotional admiration.  
*A **beautiful** party.*

<b>dame</b>	A woman of refinement. <i>A rich <b>dame</b> who took her husband to the cleaners.</i>
<b>enamored</b>	Marked by foolish or unreasoning fondness. <i>Narcissus was a beautiful Greek youth who became <b>enamored</b> of his own reflection.</i>
<b>enchantingly</b>	In a bewitching manner.
<b>gaily</b>	Without thinking of the consequences. <i>She plunged <b>gaily</b> into speculation on the stock market.</i>
<b>gem</b>	Decorate with or as with gems. <i>Tiny drops of sweat <b>gemmed</b> his forehead.</i>
<b>gorgeous</b>	Dazzlingly beautiful. <i>The weather was <b>gorgeous</b>.</i>
<b>grace</b>	In Greek mythology three beautiful goddesses Aglaia Thalia and Euphrosyne believed to personify and bestow charm grace and beauty. <i>She has all the social <b>graces</b>.</i>
<b>gracefully</b>	In a gracious or graceful manner. <i>I will <b>gracefully</b> bow out of the discussion.</i>
<b>gracious</b>	Disposed to bestow favors. <i>I am saved by God's <b>gracious</b> intervention on my behalf.</i>
<b>graciously</b>	In a gracious or graceful manner. <i>Helen <b>graciously</b> accepted the award.</i>
<b>handsome</b>	Given or giving freely. <i>He was elected by a <b>handsome</b> majority.</i>
<b>infatuated</b>	Marked by foolish or unreasoning fondness. <i>He was <b>infatuated</b> with her.</i>
<b>lovely</b>	Lovable especially in a childlike or naive way. <i>We've had a <b>lovely</b> day.</i>
<b>ma'am</b>	A woman of refinement.
<b>ogle</b>	A lecherous look. <i>A vaguely erotic <b>ogle</b>.</i>
<b>perfection</b>	The action or process of improving something until it is faultless. <i>His pursuit of golfing <b>perfection</b>.</i>
<b>perfumery</b>	A shop that sells perfumes. <i>An oil used in <b>perfumery</b>.</i>

- picturesque** (of a place or building) visually attractive, especially in a quaint or charming way.  
*A **picturesque** village.*
- pretty** Make pretty or attractive.  
***Pretty** bad.*
- ravishing** Stunningly beautiful.  
*She looked **ravishing**.*
- recherche** Lavishly elegant and refined.
- scenic** Providing or relating to views of impressive or beautiful natural scenery.  
*A **scenic** artist from the Royal Opera House.*
- smitten** Marked by foolish or unreasoning fondness.  
*Conscience **smitten**.*
- sylph** A slender graceful young woman.  
*An oh so slim **sylph** dressed in a black leotard.*
- unspoiled** Not left to spoil.  
*One of the best stretches of **unspoiled** coastline in the UK.*
