knockout	A very attractive or seductive looking woman. <i>A knockout blow.</i>
looker	A very attractive person. <i>A tough looker is not necessarily a tough fighter.</i>
lulu	An outstanding example of a particular type of person or thing. <i>As far as nightmares went this one was a lulu.</i>
mantrap	A trap for catching trespassers.
peach	A pinkish yellow colour like that of a peach. <i>The sky began to change from grey to peach.</i>
ravisher	A very attractive or seductive looking woman.

- smasher** A very attractive or seductive looking woman.
*Riot police had clashed with window **smashers**.*
- stunner** An amazing turn of events.
*The real **stunner** comes when the boy's father also blames her.*
- sweetheart** Any well-liked individual.
*Don't worry **sweetheart** I've got it all worked out.*

enamored	Marked by foolish or unreasoning fondness. <i>Narcissus was a beautiful Greek youth who became enamored of his own reflection.</i>
enchantingly	In a bewitching manner.
gaily	Without thinking of the consequences. <i>She plunged gaily into speculation on the stock market.</i>
gem	Decorate with or as with gems. <i>Tiny drops of sweat gemmed his forehead.</i>
gorgeous	Dazzlingly beautiful. <i>The weather was gorgeous.</i>
grace	In Greek mythology three beautiful goddesses Aglaia Thalia and Euphrosyne believed to personify and bestow charm grace and beauty. <i>She has all the social graces.</i>
gracefully	In a gracious or graceful manner. <i>I will gracefully bow out of the discussion.</i>
gracious	Disposed to bestow favors. <i>I am saved by God's gracious intervention on my behalf.</i>
graciously	In a gracious or graceful manner. <i>Helen graciously accepted the award.</i>
handsome	Given or giving freely. <i>He was elected by a handsome majority.</i>
infatuated	Marked by foolish or unreasoning fondness. <i>He was infatuated with her.</i>
lovely	Lovable especially in a childlike or naive way. <i>We've had a lovely day.</i>
ma'am	A woman of refinement.
ogle	A lecherous look. <i>A vaguely erotic ogle.</i>
perfection	The action or process of improving something until it is faultless. <i>His pursuit of golfing perfection.</i>
perfumery	A shop that sells perfumes. <i>An oil used in perfumery.</i>

<u>picturesque</u>	(of a place or building) visually attractive, especially in a quaint or charming way. A <i>picturesque</i> village.
<u>pretty</u>	Make pretty or attractive. <i>Pretty</i> bad.
<u>ravishing</u>	Stunningly beautiful. She looked <i>ravishing</i> .
<u>recherche</u>	Lavishly elegant and refined.
<u>scenic</u>	Providing or relating to views of impressive or beautiful natural scenery. A <i>scenic</i> artist from the Royal Opera House.
<u>smitten</u>	Marked by foolish or unreasoning fondness. Conscience <i>smitten</i> .
<u>sylph</u>	A slender graceful young woman. An oh so slim <i>sylph</i> dressed in a black leotard.
<u>unspoiled</u>	Not left to spoil. One of the best stretches of <i>unspoiled</i> coastline in the UK.
