According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “becoming” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

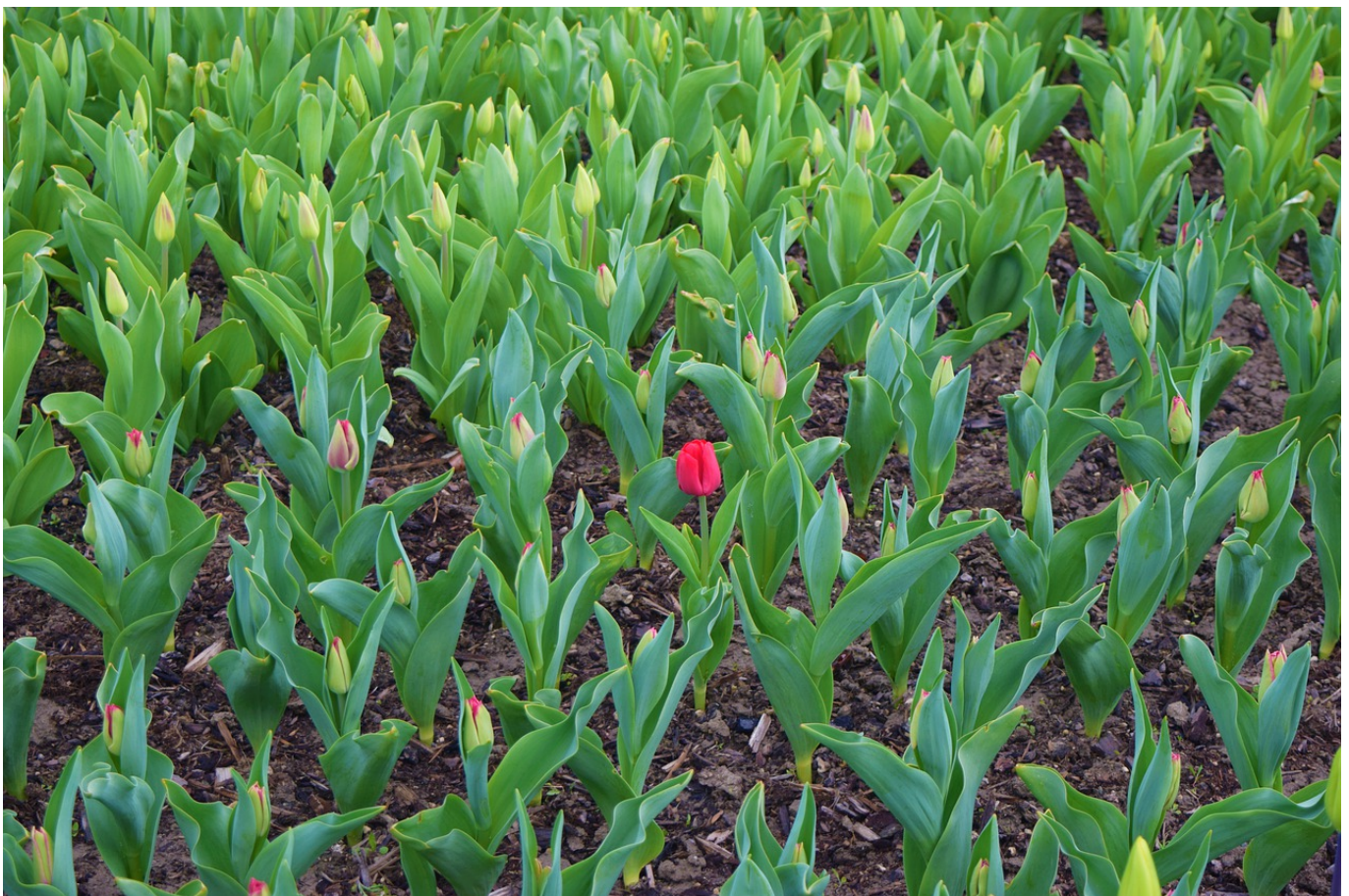
- *Suitable or appropriate.*

- *Displaying or setting off to best advantage.*
- *According with custom or propriety.*



## Synonyms of "Becoming" as an adjective (15 Words)

- attractive** Having power to arouse interest.  
*The **attractive** force between the magnets and the metal plate.*
- chic** Elegantly and stylishly fashionable.  
*She looked every inch the **chic** Frenchwoman.*
- comely** According with custom or propriety.  
*The **comely** Italian actress Valeria Golino.*
- comme il faut** According with custom or propriety.
- decorous** According with custom or propriety.  
*The **tete a tete** was **decorous** in the extreme.*
- elegant** (of a scientific theory or solution to a problem) pleasingly ingenious and simple.  
*An **elegant** comfortable house.*
- fashionable** Popular and considered appealing or fashionable at the time.  
*The **fashionable** side of town.*

<b>fetching</b>	Attractive. A <b>fetching</b> new hairstyle.
<b>flattering</b>	Full of praise and compliments. The article began with some <b>flattering</b> words about us.
<b>handsome</b>	(of a thing) well made, imposing, and of obvious quality. <b>Handsome</b> cookery books.
<b>lovely</b>	Very beautiful or attractive. <b>Lovely</b> views.
<b>pretty</b>	(used ironically) unexpectedly bad. He led me a <b>pretty</b> dance.
<b>seemly</b>	Conforming to accepted notions of propriety or good taste; decorous. I felt it was not <b>seemly</b> to observe too closely.
<b>stylish</b>	Neat, confident, and skilful. A <b>stylish</b> cocktail bar.
<b>tasteful</b>	Free from what is tawdry or unbecoming. A <b>tasteful</b> lounge bar.



## Usage Examples of "Becoming" as an adjective

- *Do not talk too much to your cousins, it's not becoming.*
- *A becoming new shade of rose.*
- *What a becoming dress!*
- *Her becoming modesty.*
- *A becoming portrait.*



## Associations of "Becoming" (30 Words)

**appearance** An act of performing or participating in a public event.  
*The rookie made a brief **appearance** in the first period.*

<b>attractive</b>	Having the properties of a magnet; the ability to draw or pull. <i>An <b>attractive</b> personality.</i>
<b>beautiful</b>	Pleasing the senses or mind aesthetically. <i>A <b>beautiful</b> painting.</i>
<b>beauty</b>	An excellent example of something. <i>I was struck by her <b>beauty</b>.</i>
<b>blouse</b>	A loose linen or cotton garment formerly worn by peasants and manual workers, typically belted at the waist. <i>I <b>bloused</b> my trousers over my boots.</i>
<b>bodice</b>	The close-fitting upper part of a dress, covering the chest and back above the waist.
<b>cajolery</b>	Coaxing or flattery intended to persuade someone to do something. <i>She uses <b>cajolery</b> deception and manipulation to get what she wants.</i>
<b>comeliness</b>	The quality of being good looking and attractive.
<b>comely</b>	Very pleasing to the eye. <i><b>Comely</b> behavior.</i>
<b>corset</b>	Dress with a corset.
<b>decent</b>	Decently clothed. <i>People need <b>decent</b> homes.</i>
<b>decorous</b>	Characterized by propriety and dignity and good taste in manners and conduct. <i>The <b>tete a tete</b> was <b>decorous</b> in the extreme.</i>
<b>dress</b>	Put a dressing on. <i>After you <b>dress</b> a dry fly be sure to remove any oil before you make your next cast.</i>
<b>enchanting</b>	Capturing interest as if by a spell. <i>Dinah looked <b>enchanting</b>.</i>
<b>enticing</b>	Attractive or tempting; alluring. <i>Difficult to say no to an <b>enticing</b> advertisement.</i>
<b>flattering</b>	Full of praise and compliments. <i>It was <b>flattering</b> to have a pretty girl like Fiona so obviously fond of him.</i>
<b>formal</b>	Being in accord with established forms and conventions and requirements as e.g. of formal dress. <i>Pay one's <b>formal</b> respects.</i>
<b>garment</b>	Provide with clothes or put clothes on. <i>A windproof outer <b>garment</b>.</i>

<b>glamorize</b>	Interpret romantically. <i>The lyrics <b>glamorize</b> drugs.</i>
<b>gown</b>	A dressing gown. <i>A silk ball <b>gown</b>.</i>
<b>groveling</b>	Totally submissive.
<b>ingratiating</b>	Intended to gain approval or favour; sycophantic. <i>A smooth <b>ingratiating</b> manner.</i>
<b>jacket</b>	A jacket potato. <i>The men were <b>jacketed</b>.</i>
<b><u>pants</u></b>	Underpants or knickers. <i>Corduroy <b>pants</b>.</i>
<b>raiment</b>	Especially fine or decorative clothing. <i>Ladies clothed in <b>raiment</b> bedecked with jewels.</i>
<b>sartorial</b>	Relating to tailoring, clothes, or style of dress. <i><b>Sartorial</b> elegance.</i>
<b>seemly</b>	Conforming to accepted notions of propriety or good taste; decorous. <i><b>Seemly</b> behavior.</i>
<b><u>shirt</u></b>	A garment similar to a shirt made of stretchable material and typically having a short row of buttons at the neck worn as casual wear or for sports. <i>Tonight he s smartly dressed in <b>shirt</b> and tie.</i>
<b><u>suave</u></b>	Having a sophisticated charm. <i>All the waiters were <b>suave</b> and deferential.</i>
<b><u>tempting</u></b>	Very pleasantly inviting. <i>It is often <b>tempting</b> to bring about change rapidly.</i>
