According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “becoming” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

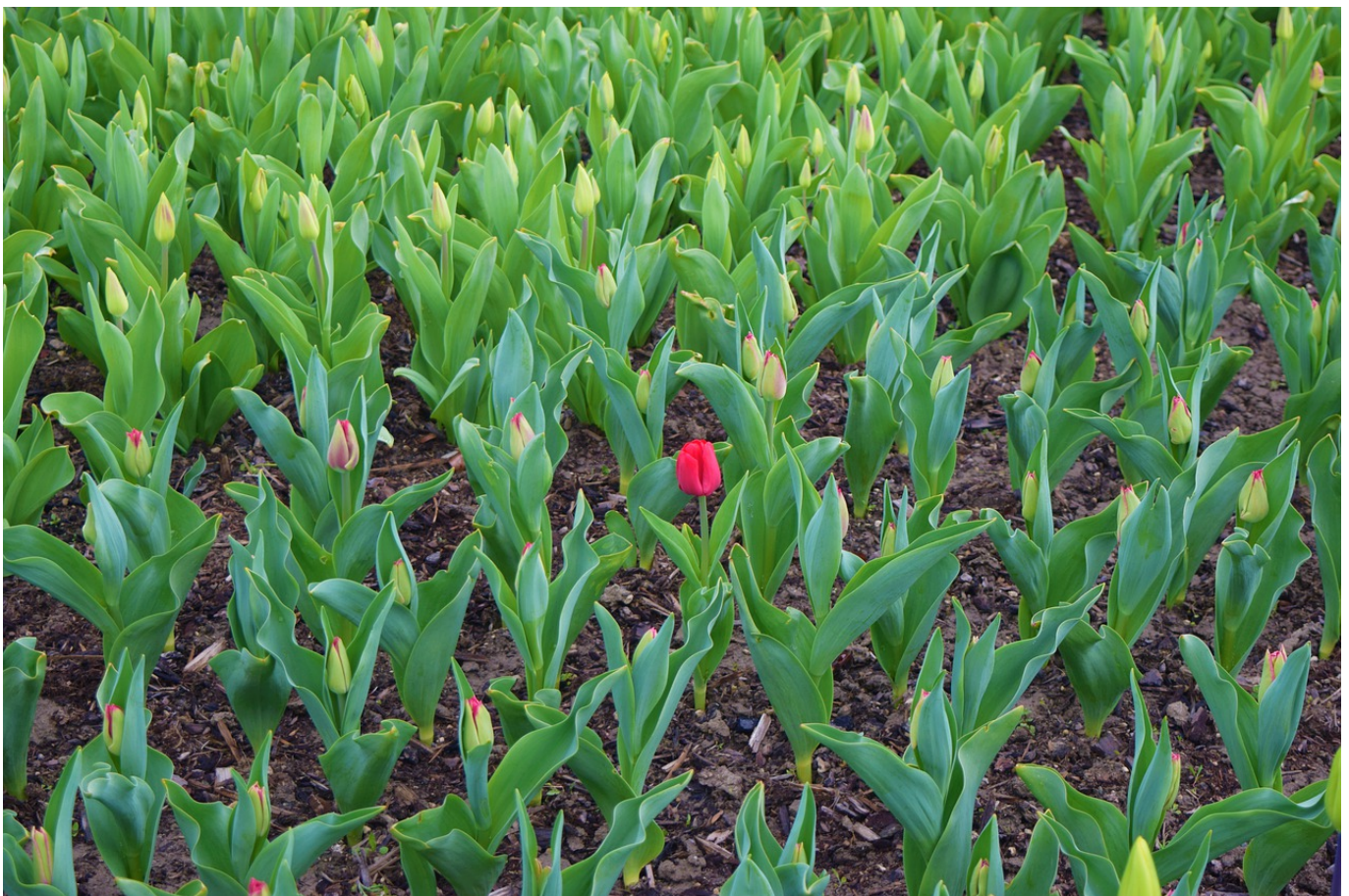
- *Suitable or appropriate.*

- *According with custom or propriety.*



Synonyms of "Becoming" as an adjective (15 Words)

attractive	Having power to arouse interest. <i>The attractive force between the magnets and the metal plate.</i>
chic	Elegantly and stylishly fashionable. <i>She looked every inch the chic Frenchwoman.</i>
comely	According with custom or propriety. <i>The comely Italian actress Valeria Golino.</i>
comme il faut	According with custom or propriety.
decorous	According with custom or propriety. <i>The tete a tete was decorous in the extreme.</i>
elegant	(of a scientific theory or solution to a problem) pleasingly ingenious and simple. <i>An elegant comfortable house.</i>
fashionable	Popular and considered appealing or fashionable at the time. <i>The fashionable side of town.</i>

fetching	Attractive. <i>A fetching new hairstyle.</i>
flattering	Full of praise and compliments. <i>The article began with some flattering words about us.</i>
handsome	(of a thing) well made, imposing, and of obvious quality. <i>Handsome cookery books.</i>
lovely	Very beautiful or attractive. <i>Lovely views.</i>
pretty	(used ironically) unexpectedly bad. <i>He led me a pretty dance.</i>
seemly	Conforming to accepted notions of propriety or good taste; decorous. <i>I felt it was not seemly to observe too closely.</i>
stylish	Neat, confident, and skilful. <i>A stylish cocktail bar.</i>
tasteful	Free from what is tawdry or unbecoming. <i>A tasteful lounge bar.</i>



Usage Examples of "Becoming" as an adjective

- *Do not talk too much to your cousins, it's not becoming.*
- *A becoming new shade of rose.*
- *What a becoming dress!*
- *Her becoming modesty.*
- *A becoming portrait.*



Associations of "Becoming" (30 Words)

appearance An act of performing or participating in a public event.
*The rookie made a brief **appearance** in the first period.*

attractive	Having the properties of a magnet; the ability to draw or pull. <i>An attractive personality.</i>
beautiful	Pleasing the senses or mind aesthetically. <i>A beautiful painting.</i>
beauty	An excellent example of something. <i>I was struck by her beauty.</i>
blouse	A loose linen or cotton garment formerly worn by peasants and manual workers, typically belted at the waist. <i>I bloused my trousers over my boots.</i>
bodice	The close-fitting upper part of a dress, covering the chest and back above the waist.
cajolery	Coaxing or flattery intended to persuade someone to do something. <i>She uses cajolery deception and manipulation to get what she wants.</i>
comeliness	The quality of being good looking and attractive.
comely	Very pleasing to the eye. <i>Comely behavior.</i>
corset	Dress with a corset.
decent	Decently clothed. <i>People need decent homes.</i>
decorous	Characterized by propriety and dignity and good taste in manners and conduct. <i>The tete a tete was decorous in the extreme.</i>
dress	Put a dressing on. <i>After you dress a dry fly be sure to remove any oil before you make your next cast.</i>
enchancing	Capturing interest as if by a spell. <i>Dinah looked enchancing.</i>
enticing	Attractive or tempting; alluring. <i>Difficult to say no to an enticing advertisement.</i>
flattering	Full of praise and compliments. <i>It was flattering to have a pretty girl like Fiona so obviously fond of him.</i>
formal	Being in accord with established forms and conventions and requirements as e g of formal dress. <i>Pay one s formal respects.</i>
garment	Provide with clothes or put clothes on. <i>A windproof outer garment.</i>

glamorize	Interpret romantically. <i>The lyrics glamorize drugs.</i>
gown	A dressing gown. <i>A silk ball gown.</i>
groveling	Totally submissive.
ingratiating	Intended to gain approval or favour; sycophantic. <i>A smooth ingratiating manner.</i>
jacket	A jacket potato. <i>The men were jacketed.</i>
<u>pants</u>	Underpants or knickers. <i>Corduroy pants.</i>
raiment	Especially fine or decorative clothing. <i>Ladies clothed in raiment bedecked with jewels.</i>
sartorial	Relating to tailoring, clothes, or style of dress. <i>Sartorial elegance.</i>
seemly	Conforming to accepted notions of propriety or good taste; decorous. <i>Seemly behavior.</i>
<u>shirt</u>	A garment similar to a shirt made of stretchable material and typically having a short row of buttons at the neck worn as casual wear or for sports. <i>Tonight he s smartly dressed in shirt and tie.</i>
<u>suave</u>	Having a sophisticated charm. <i>All the waiters were suave and deferential.</i>
<u>tempting</u>	Very pleasantly inviting. <i>It is often tempting to bring about change rapidly.</i>
