# **Conjugate Bedear**

### **Bedear in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>bedear</b>	We <b>bedear</b>
You <b>bedear</b>	You <b>bedear</b>
He/She/It <b>bedears</b>	They <b>bedear</b>

## **Bedear in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am bedearing	We <b>are bedearing</b>
You <b>are bedearing</b>	You <b>are bedearing</b>
He/She/It is bedearing	They are bedearing

#### **Bedear in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have bedeared	We have bedeared
You have bedeared	You have bedeared
He/She/It has bedeared	They have bedeared

### **Bedear in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been bedearing	We have been bedearing
You <b>have been bedearing</b>	You have been bedearing
He/She/It has been bedearing	They have been bedearing

## **Bedear in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I bedeared	We <b>bedeared</b>
You <b>bedeared</b>	You <b>bedeared</b>
He/She/It <b>bedeared</b>	They <b>bedeared</b>

## **Bedear in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



SingularPluralI was bedearingWe were bedearingYou were bedearingYou were bedearingHe/She/It was bedearingThey were bedearing

#### **Bedear in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had bedeared	We had bedeared
You had bedeared	You had bedeared
He/She/It had bedeared	They had bedeared

#### **Bedear in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been bedearing	We had been bedearing
You <b>had been bedearing</b>	You had been bedearing
He/She/It had been bedearing	They had been bedearing

## **Bedear in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>will bedear</b>	We <b>will bedear</b>
You <b>will bedear</b>	You <b>will bedear</b>
He/She/It will bedear	They will bedear

### **Bedear in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be bedearing	We <b>will be bedearing</b>
You <b>will be bedearing</b>	You will be bedearing
He/She/It will be bedearing	They will be bedearing

#### **Bedear in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular	Plural
I will have bedeared	We will have bedeared
You <b>will have bedeared</b>	You will have bedeared
He/She/It will have bedeared	They will have bedeared

## **Bedear in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been bedearing	We <b>will have been bedearing</b>
You <b>will have been bedearing</b>	You <b>will have been bedearing</b>
He/She/It will have been bedearing	They will have been bedearing
