Begin in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am beginning We are beginning
You are beginning You are beginning
He/She/It is beginning They are beginning

Begin in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have begun
You have begun
You have begun
He/She/It has begun They have begun

Begin in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been beginning
You have been beginning
He/She/It has been beginning
They have been beginning

Begin in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I began We began
You began You began
He/She/It began They began

Begin in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was beginning We were beginning
You were beginning
He/She/It was beginning They were beginning

Begin in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural
I had begun We had begun
You had begun You had begun
He/She/It had begun They had begun

Begin in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been beginning
You had been beginning
He/She/It had been beginning
They had been beginning

Begin in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I will begin We will begin
You will begin You will begin
He/She/It will begin They will begin

Begin in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be beginning
You will be beginning
He/She/It will be beginning
They will be beginning

Begin in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have begun
You will have begun
You will have begun
He/She/It will have begun
They will have begun

Begin in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been beginning
You will have been beginning
He/She/It will have been beginning
They will have been beginning
