- *A person just starting to learn a skill or take part in an activity.*



## Synonyms of "Beginner" as a noun (14 Words)

<b><u>apprentice</u></b>	A beginner. An <b>apprentice</b> electrician.
<b>father</b>	A male parent also used as a term of address to your father. He s held to be the <b>father</b> of abstract art.
<b><u>founder</u></b>	A person who manufactures articles of cast metal; the owner or operator of a foundry. An iron <b>founder</b> .
<b>founding father</b>	Food and lodging provided in addition to money.
<b>initiate</b>	A person who has been initiated into an organization or activity. An <b>initiate</b> of the cult.
<b><u>learner</u></b>	Works for an expert to learn a trade. A fast <b>learner</b> .
<b>novice</b>	Someone who has entered a religious order but has not taken final vows. Last season as a <b>novice</b> he won three races.
<b>probationer</b>	Someone released on probation or on parole.
<b>pupil</b>	The contractile aperture in the center of the iris of the eye; resembles a large black dot. Will you take me on as your <b>pupil</b> .

<b><u>starter</u></b>	A topic, question, or other item with which to start a group discussion or course of study. <i>The <b>starter</b> motor.</i>
<b>student</b>	Denoting someone who is studying in order to enter a particular profession. <i>High school <b>students</b>.</i>
<b>tyro</b>	Someone new to a field or activity.
<b><u>trainee</u></b>	A person undergoing training for a particular job or profession. <i><b>Trainee</b> solicitors.</i>
<b>tyro</b>	Someone new to a field or activity.

<b>amateur</b>	An athlete who does not play for pay. <i>An <b>amateur</b> photographer.</i>
<u><a href="#">apprentice</a></u>	Be or work as an apprentice. <i>An <b>apprentice</b> barman.</i>
<b>entrant</b>	One who enters a competition. <i>A well publicized <b>entrant</b> is the pocket computer.</i>
<u><a href="#">exercising</a></u>	The activity of exerting your muscles in various ways to keep fit. <i>He did some <b>exercising</b>.</i>
<u><a href="#">fledgling</a></u>	A young bird that has just fledged. <i>A <b>fledgling</b> enterprise.</i>
<u><a href="#">founder</a></u>	Stumble and nearly fall. <i>An iron <b>founder</b>.</i>
<b>freshen</b>	(of a cow) give birth and come into milk. <i>She <b>freshened</b> up after the tennis game.</i>
<b>freshman</b>	A first-year undergraduate. <i>A <b>freshman</b> senator.</i>
<b>grader</b>	A pupil of a specified grade in a school. <i>A first <b>grader</b>.</i>
<b>inexperienced</b>	Lacking practical experience or training. <i>An <b>inexperienced</b> driver.</i>
<b>laity</b>	Lay people, as distinct from the clergy.
<b>layman</b>	A person without professional or specialized knowledge in a particular subject. <i>He was an active Catholic <b>layman</b>.</i>
<u><a href="#">learner</a></u>	Someone (especially a child) who learns (as from a teacher) or takes up knowledge or beliefs. <i>A fast <b>learner</b>.</i>
<u><a href="#">neophyte</a></u>	A new convert to a religion. <i>A cast of <b>neophyte</b> actors.</i>
<b>nestling</b>	Young bird not yet fledged. <i>Buntings their throats bulging with food for hungry <b>nestlings</b>.</i>
<b>newbie</b>	An inexperienced newcomer to a particular activity.
<u><a href="#">newcomer</a></u>	Any new participant in some activity. <i>She s a <b>newcomer</b> to the area.</i>

<b>novice</b>	A person new to and inexperienced in a job or situation. <i>Last season as a <b>novice</b> he won three races.</i>
<b>prentice</b>	Works for an expert to learn a trade. <i>A tailor s <b>prentice</b>.</i>
<b><u>rookie</u></b>	A new recruit, especially in the army or police. <i>A <b>rookie</b> cop.</i>
<b>sophomore</b>	Used of the second year in United States high school or college. <i>The Canadian filmmaker s <b>sophomore</b> movie is a father son story.</i>
<b><u>starter</u></b>	A person who gives the signal for the start of a race. <i>Consumers upgrading from a regular mobile phone to a <b>starter</b> smartphone.</i>
<b>student</b>	A school pupil. <i>A <b>student</b> of the free market.</i>
<b><u>trainee</u></b>	Someone who is being trained. <i><b>Trainee</b> solicitors.</i>
<b>tutorial</b>	An account or explanation of a subject, printed or on a computer screen, intended for private study. <i>Online <b>tutorials</b> and reference guides.</i>
<b>tyro</b>	A beginner or novice.
<b>unpracticed</b>	Not having had extensive practice.
<b><u>unprofessional</u></b>	Not characteristic of or befitting a profession or one engaged in a profession. <i>Described in <b>unprofessional</b> language so that high school students could understand it.</i>
<b><u>unused</u></b>	Not yet used or soiled. <i>Any <b>unused</b> equipment will be welcomed back.</i>
<b>wright</b>	United States early feminist (born in Scotland) (1795-1852).
