Definitions of "Beginner" as a noun

- *Someone new to a field or activity.*
- *A person who founds or establishes some institution.*
- *A person just starting to learn a skill or take part in an activity.*



Synonyms of "Beginner" as a noun (14 Words)

apprentice	A beginner. <i>An apprentice electrician.</i>
father	A male parent also used as a term of address to your father. <i>He s held to be the father of abstract art.</i>
founder	A person who manufactures articles of cast metal; the owner or operator of a foundry. <i>An iron founder.</i>
founding father	Food and lodging provided in addition to money.
initiate	A person who has been initiated into an organization or activity. <i>An initiate of the cult.</i>
learner	Works for an expert to learn a trade. <i>A fast learner.</i>
novice	Someone who has entered a religious order but has not taken final vows. <i>Last season as a novice he won three races.</i>
probationer	Someone released on probation or on parole.
pupil	The contractile aperture in the center of the iris of the eye; resembles a large black dot. <i>Will you take me on as your pupil.</i>

<u>starter</u>	A topic, question, or other item with which to start a group discussion or course of study. <i>The starter motor.</i>
student	Denoting someone who is studying in order to enter a particular profession. <i>High school students.</i>
tyro	Someone new to a field or activity.
<u>trainee</u>	A person undergoing training for a particular job or profession. <i>Trainee solicitors.</i>
tyro	Someone new to a field or activity.

Associations of "Beginner" (30 Words)

amateur	An athlete who does not play for pay. <i>An amateur photographer.</i>
<u>apprentice</u>	Be or work as an apprentice. <i>An apprentice barman.</i>
entrant	One who enters a competition. <i>A well publicized entrant is the pocket computer.</i>
<u>exercising</u>	The activity of exerting your muscles in various ways to keep fit. <i>He did some exercising.</i>
<u>fledgling</u>	A young bird that has just fledged. <i>A fledgling enterprise.</i>
<u>founder</u>	Stumble and nearly fall. <i>An iron founder.</i>
freshen	(of a cow) give birth and come into milk. <i>She freshened up after the tennis game.</i>
freshman	A first-year undergraduate. <i>A freshman senator.</i>
grader	A pupil of a specified grade in a school. <i>A first grader.</i>
inexperienced	Lacking practical experience or training. <i>An inexperienced driver.</i>
laity	Lay people, as distinct from the clergy.
layman	A person without professional or specialized knowledge in a particular subject. <i>He was an active Catholic layman.</i>
<u>learner</u>	Someone (especially a child) who learns (as from a teacher) or takes up knowledge or beliefs. <i>A fast learner.</i>
<u>neophyte</u>	A new convert to a religion. <i>A cast of neophyte actors.</i>
nestling	Young bird not yet fledged. <i>Buntings their throats bulging with food for hungry nestlings.</i>
newbie	An inexperienced newcomer to a particular activity.
<u>newcomer</u>	Any new participant in some activity. <i>She s a newcomer to the area.</i>

novice	A person new to and inexperienced in a job or situation. <i>Last season as a novice he won three races.</i>
prentice	Works for an expert to learn a trade. <i>A tailor s prentice.</i>
rookie	A new recruit, especially in the army or police. <i>A rookie cop.</i>
sophomore	Used of the second year in United States high school or college. <i>The Canadian filmmaker s sophomore movie is a father son story.</i>
starter	A person who gives the signal for the start of a race. <i>Consumers upgrading from a regular mobile phone to a starter smartphone.</i>
student	A school pupil. <i>A student of the free market.</i>
trainee	Someone who is being trained. <i>Trainee solicitors.</i>
tutorial	An account or explanation of a subject, printed or on a computer screen, intended for private study. <i>Online tutorials and reference guides.</i>
tyro	A beginner or novice.
unpracticed	Not having had extensive practice.
unprofessional	Not characteristic of or befitting a profession or one engaged in a profession. <i>Described in unprofessional language so that high school students could understand it.</i>
unused	Not yet used or soiled. <i>Any unused equipment will be welcomed back.</i>
wright	United States early feminist (born in Scotland) (1795-1852).
