| after | At a later or future time afterwards. <i>Two hours after that.</i> |
| axle | A shaft on which a wheel rotates. <i>North American railways operate cars at much higher axle loads.</i> |
| <u>back</u> | Cause to move backwards. <i>The back garden.</i> |
| backward | At or to or toward the back or rear. <i>Backward square leg.</i> |
| backwards | In reverse of the usual direction or order. <i>He took a step backwards.</i> |
| <u>backwater</u> | An isolated or peaceful place. <i>Nothing spoils the tranquillity of this quiet backwater.</i> |
| <u>below</u> | On a floor below. <i>I ll go below and fix us a drink.</i> |
| <u>beneath</u> | Extending or directly underneath something. <i>A house built on stilts to allow air to circulate beneath.</i> |
| <u>crypt</u> | A small tubular gland, pit, or recess. |
| degeneracy | Moral perversion; impairment of virtue and moral principles. <i>A slide into moral degeneracy.</i> |
| dorsal | Facing away from the axis of an organ or organism. <i>The dorsal aorta.</i> |
| <u>inferiority</u> | An inferior quality. <i>His sense of failure adds to his feelings of inferiority.</i> |
| <u>lag</u> | Cover with lagging to prevent heat loss. <i>They waited for Tim who was lagging behind.</i> |

| latency | The delay before a transfer of data begins following an instruction for its transfer. <i>Subscribers can expect some latency time when issuing a request.</i> |
| later | At or toward an end or late period or stage of development. <i>A later symptom of the disease.</i> |
| locale | The scene of any event or action (especially the place of a meeting). <i>Her summers were spent in a variety of exotic locales.</i> |
| medial | Situated near the median plane of the body or the midline of an organ. <i>A medial consonant.</i> |
| posterior | A person's buttocks. <i>A date posterior to the first Reform Bill.</i> |
| posthumous | (of a child) born after the death of its father. <i>He was awarded a posthumous Military Cross.</i> |
| rear | Located in or toward the back or rear. <i>On the rearward side.</i> |
| retreat | Make a retreat from an earlier commitment or activity. <i>The French retreated in disarray.</i> |
| retroactive | (especially of legislation) taking effect from a date in the past. <i>A big retroactive tax increase.</i> |
| scenic | Relating to theatrical scenery. <i>The trend to scenic figural work.</i> |
| subsequent | Coming after something in time; following. <i>The theory was developed subsequent to the earthquake of 1906.</i> |
| subterranean | Lying beyond what is openly revealed or avowed (especially being kept in the background or deliberately concealed). <i>The terrors and hazards of subterranean exploration.</i> |
| tail | The rear part of an aeroplane with the tailplane and rudder. <i>I can't put a tail on him I don't know where he's gone.</i> |
| ulterior | Beyond or outside an area of immediate interest; remote- G.B.Shaw. <i>Without ulterior argument.</i> |
| underneath | On the lower or downward side; on the underside of. <i>Paint was peeling off in flakes to reveal greyish plaster underneath.</i> |
| ventral | On or relating to the underside of an animal or plant; abdominal. <i>The ventral part of the head.</i> |
| vista | A mental view of a succession of remembered or anticipated events. <i>Sweeping lawns and landscaped vistas.</i> |
