## Associations of "Behind the scenes" (30 Words)

<b>after</b>	At a later or future time afterwards. <i>Two hours <b>after</b> that.</i>
<b>axle</b>	A shaft on which a wheel rotates. <i>North American railways operate cars at much higher <b>axle</b> loads.</i>
<b><u>back</u></b>	Cause to move backwards. <i>The <b>back</b> garden.</i>
<b>backward</b>	At or to or toward the back or rear. <i><b>Backward</b> square leg.</i>
<b>backwards</b>	In reverse of the usual direction or order. <i>He took a step <b>backwards</b>.</i>
<b><u>backwater</u></b>	An isolated or peaceful place. <i>Nothing spoils the tranquillity of this quiet <b>backwater</b>.</i>
<b><u>below</u></b>	On a floor below. <i>I ll go <b>below</b> and fix us a drink.</i>
<b><u>beneath</u></b>	Extending or directly underneath something. <i>A house built on stilts to allow air to circulate <b>beneath</b>.</i>
<b><u>crypt</u></b>	A small tubular gland, pit, or recess.
<b>degeneracy</b>	Moral perversion; impairment of virtue and moral principles. <i>A slide into moral <b>degeneracy</b>.</i>
<b>dorsal</b>	Facing away from the axis of an organ or organism. <i>The <b>dorsal</b> aorta.</i>
<b><u>inferiority</u></b>	An inferior quality. <i>His sense of failure adds to his feelings of <b>inferiority</b>.</i>
<b><u>lag</u></b>	Cover with lagging to prevent heat loss. <i>They waited for Tim who was <b>lagging</b> behind.</i>

<b>latency</b>	The delay before a transfer of data begins following an instruction for its transfer. <i>Subscribers can expect some <b>latency</b> time when issuing a request.</i>
<b>later</b>	At or toward an end or late period or stage of development. <i>A <b>later</b> symptom of the disease.</i>
<b>locale</b>	The scene of any event or action (especially the place of a meeting). <i>Her summers were spent in a variety of exotic <b>locales</b>.</i>
<b>medial</b>	Situated near the median plane of the body or the midline of an organ. <i>A <b>medial</b> consonant.</i>
<b>posterior</b>	A person's buttocks. <i>A date <b>posterior</b> to the first Reform Bill.</i>
<b>posthumous</b>	(of a child) born after the death of its father. <i>He was awarded a <b>posthumous</b> Military Cross.</i>
<b>rear</b>	Located in or toward the back or rear. <i>On the <b>rearward</b> side.</i>
<b>retreat</b>	Make a retreat from an earlier commitment or activity. <i>The French <b>retreated</b> in disarray.</i>
<b>retroactive</b>	(especially of legislation) taking effect from a date in the past. <i>A big <b>retroactive</b> tax increase.</i>
<b>scenic</b>	Relating to theatrical scenery. <i>The trend to <b>scenic</b> figural work.</i>
<b>subsequent</b>	Coming after something in time; following. <i>The theory was developed <b>subsequent</b> to the earthquake of 1906.</i>
<b>subterranean</b>	Lying beyond what is openly revealed or avowed (especially being kept in the background or deliberately concealed). <i>The terrors and hazards of <b>subterranean</b> exploration.</i>
<b>tail</b>	The rear part of an aeroplane with the tailplane and rudder. <i>I can't put a <b>tail</b> on him I don't know where he's gone.</i>
<b>ulterior</b>	Beyond or outside an area of immediate interest; remote- G.B.Shaw. <i>Without <b>ulterior</b> argument.</i>
<b>underneath</b>	On the lower or downward side; on the underside of. <i>Paint was peeling off in flakes to reveal greyish plaster <b>underneath</b>.</i>
<b>ventral</b>	On or relating to the underside of an animal or plant; abdominal. <i>The <b>ventral</b> part of the head.</i>
<b>vista</b>	A mental view of a succession of remembered or anticipated events. <i>Sweeping lawns and landscaped <b>vistas</b>.</i>
