- *(of a place) surrounded by armed forces aiming to capture it or force surrender; besieged.*

Synonyms of "Beleaguered" as an adjective (14 Words)

besieged	Surrounded by hostile forces. <i>The besieged town.</i>
blockaded	Preventing entry or exit or a course of action. <i>The blockaded harbor.</i>
encircled	Confined on all sides. <i>The encircled pioneers.</i>
hard-pressed	Facing or experiencing financial trouble or difficulty.
in a tight corner	Currently fashionable.
in a tight spot	Currently fashionable.
in difficulties	Currently fashionable.

surrounded

Confined on all sides.
A camp **surrounded** by enemies.

troubled

Characterized by or indicative of distress or affliction or danger or need.
A **troubled** expression.

under attack

Lower in rank, power, or authority.

under pressure

Lower in rank, power, or authority.

under siege

Located below or beneath something else.

under stress

Located below or beneath something else.

with one's back to the wall Related to or located at the back.

Usage Examples of "Beleaguered" as an adjective

- *The board is supporting the beleaguered director amid calls for his resignation.*
- *He led a relief force to the aid of the beleaguered city.*
