include	Have as a part, be made up out of. <i>The price includes dinner bed and breakfast.</i>
<u>let</u>	A property available for rent. Let A and B stand for X and Y respectively.
maintenance	Means of maintenance of a family or group. Essential maintenance work.
<u>own</u>	Have something as one s own possess. I was an outcast among my own kind.
<u>possess</u>	Have ownership or possession of. I tried to possess my soul in patience.
postponement	Act of putting off to a future time. The postponement of the elections.
<u>retain</u>	Allow to remain in a place or position or maintain a property or feature. <i>This garment</i> retain s its shape even after many washings.
retention	The fact of keeping something in one's memory. The retention of direct control by central government.
