Below as an Adverb

Definitions of "Below" as an adverb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “below” as an adverb can have the following definitions:

- *On a floor below.*
- *(in writing) at a later place.*
- *At a later place.*
- *(in printed text) mentioned further down on the same page, or further on in the text.*
- *See below.*
- *Further down.*
- *Below deck.*
- *At a lower level or layer.*
- *In or to a place that is lower.*



Synonyms of "Below" as an adverb (10 Words)

beneath

Hidden behind an appearance.

*Upper layers can be removed to reveal internal parts **beneath**.*

down the stairs

To a lower intensity.

downstairs

On a floor below.

*I tripped over the cat and fell **downstairs**.*

further down

To or at a greater distance in time or space (‘farther’ is used more frequently than ‘further’ in this physical sense).

further on

To or at a greater distance in time or space (‘farther’ is used more frequently than ‘further’ in this physical sense).

in a later place

To or toward the inside of.

in a lower position

To or toward the inside of.

infra

(in a written document) below; further on.

*Vide **infra**.*

under

Under water.

*The operation was quick she was only **under** for 15 minutes.*

underneath

Under or below an object or a surface; at a lower place or level; directly beneath.

*Paint was peeling off in flakes to reveal greyish plaster **underneath**.*



Usage Examples of "Below" as an adverb

- *Our nutritionist is pictured below right.*
- *He jumped from the window into the moat below.*
- *See below.*
- *I'll go below and fix us a drink.*



Associations of "Below" (30 Words)

behind	A kick that sends the ball over a behind line or a touch that sends it between the inner posts scoring one point. <i>He fell behind with his mortgage payments.</i>
beneath	In or to a place that is lower. <i>A house built on stilts to allow air to circulate beneath.</i>
bottom	Provide with a bottom or a seat. <i>I was put in the bottom class.</i>
burial	A grave or the remains found in it. <i>They will give him a proper burial.</i>
bury	Cover (someone or something) completely. <i>He ran through to bury a right foot shot inside the near post.</i>
casket	Enclose in a casket. <i>A small brass casket containing four black opals.</i>

<u>cemetery</u>	A tract of land used for burials. <i>A military cemetery.</i>
<u>crypt</u>	An underground room or vault beneath a church, used as a chapel or burial place.
<u>down</u>	Cause to come or go down. <i>One down and only six more to go.</i>
downstairs	Situated downstairs. <i>The downstairs or downstair phone.</i>
entomb	Place (a dead body) in a tomb. <i>The pharaohs were entombed in the pyramids.</i>
inhume	Place in a grave or tomb. <i>No hand his bones shall gather or inhume.</i>
inter	Place in a grave or tomb. <i>He was interred with the military honours due to him.</i>
interment	The ritual placing of a corpse in a grave. <i>Interments took place in the churchyard.</i>
located	Situated in a particular spot or position. <i>Valuable centrally located urban land.</i>
<u>low</u>	Of a river or lake below the usual water level. <i>She pressed on bent low to protect her face.</i>
mausoleum	A stately or impressive building housing a tomb or group of tombs. <i>A cultural mausoleum such as the Tate.</i>
necropolis	A tract of land used for burials.
nether	Dwelling beneath the surface of the earth. <i>Nether regions.</i>
place	Put into a certain place or abstract location. <i>A survey placed the company 13th for achievement.</i>
sepulcher	A chamber that is used as a grave.
<u>situated</u>	Situated in a particular spot or position. <i>Nicely situated on a quiet riverbank.</i>
subnormal	A person of less than normal intelligence. <i>Subnormal intelligence.</i>
<u>subterranean</u>	Lying beyond what is openly revealed or avowed (especially being kept in the background or deliberately concealed). <i>Subterranean passages.</i>

- tomb** A place for the burial of a corpse especially beneath the ground and marked by a tombstone.
*The house was as quiet as a **tomb**.*
- under** Under water.
*The **under** parts of a machine.*
- underground** A member of an underground political group or movement.
*An **underground** car park.*
- underneath** Situated directly below something else.
*He was wearing a brown jacket with a white T shirt **underneath**.*
- underpass** An underground tunnel or passage enabling pedestrians to cross a road or railway.
- underside** The lower side of anything.
*The butterfly s wings have a mottled brown pattern on the **underside**.*
