## **Below as an Adverb**

### **Definitions of "Below" as an adverb**

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “below” as an adverb can have the following definitions:

- *On a floor below.*
- *(in writing) at a later place.*
- *At a later place.*
- *(in printed text) mentioned further down on the same page, or further on in the text.*
- *See below.*
- *Further down.*
- *Below deck.*
- *At a lower level or layer.*
- *In or to a place that is lower.*



## Synonyms of "Below" as an adverb (10 Words)

### **beneath**

Hidden behind an appearance.

*Upper layers can be removed to reveal internal parts **beneath**.*

### **down the stairs**

To a lower intensity.

### **downstairs**

On a floor below.

*I tripped over the cat and fell **downstairs**.*

### **further down**

To or at a greater distance in time or space (‘farther’ is used more frequently than ‘further’ in this physical sense).

### **further on**

To or at a greater distance in time or space (‘farther’ is used more frequently than ‘further’ in this physical sense).

### **in a later place**

To or toward the inside of.

### **in a lower position**

To or toward the inside of.

### **infra**

(in a written document) below; further on.

*Vide **infra**.*

**under**

Under water.

*The operation was quick she was only **under** for 15 minutes.*

**underneath**

Under or below an object or a surface; at a lower place or level; directly beneath.

*Paint was peeling off in flakes to reveal greyish plaster **underneath**.*



**Usage Examples of "Below" as an adverb**

- *Our nutritionist is pictured below right.*
- *He jumped from the window into the moat below.*
- *See below.*
- *I'll go below and fix us a drink.*



## Associations of "Below" (30 Words)

<b>behind</b>	A kick that sends the ball over a behind line or a touch that sends it between the inner posts scoring one point. <i>He fell <b>behind</b> with his mortgage payments.</i>
<b>beneath</b>	In or to a place that is lower. <i>A house built on stilts to allow air to circulate <b>beneath</b>.</i>
<b>bottom</b>	Provide with a bottom or a seat. <i>I was put in the <b>bottom</b> class.</i>
<b>burial</b>	A grave or the remains found in it. <i>They will give him a proper <b>burial</b>.</i>
<b>bury</b>	Cover (someone or something) completely. <i>He ran through to <b>bury</b> a right foot shot inside the near post.</i>
<b>casket</b>	Enclose in a casket. <i>A small brass <b>casket</b> containing four black opals.</i>

<b><u>cemetery</u></b>	A tract of land used for burials. <i>A military <b>cemetery</b>.</i>
<b><u>crypt</u></b>	An underground room or vault beneath a church, used as a chapel or burial place.
<b><u>down</u></b>	Cause to come or go down. <i>One <b>down</b> and only six more to go.</i>
<b>downstairs</b>	Situated downstairs. <i>The <b>downstairs</b> or downstair phone.</i>
<b>entomb</b>	Place (a dead body) in a tomb. <i>The pharaohs were <b>entombed</b> in the pyramids.</i>
<b>inhume</b>	Place in a grave or tomb. <i>No hand his bones shall gather or <b>inhume</b>.</i>
<b>inter</b>	Place in a grave or tomb. <i>He was <b>interred</b> with the military honours due to him.</i>
<b>interment</b>	The ritual placing of a corpse in a grave. <i><b>Interments</b> took place in the churchyard.</i>
<b>located</b>	Situated in a particular spot or position. <i>Valuable centrally <b>located</b> urban land.</i>
<b><u>low</u></b>	Of a river or lake below the usual water level. <i>She pressed on bent <b>low</b> to protect her face.</i>
<b>mausoleum</b>	A stately or impressive building housing a tomb or group of tombs. <i>A cultural <b>mausoleum</b> such as the Tate.</i>
<b>necropolis</b>	A tract of land used for burials.
<b>nether</b>	Dwelling beneath the surface of the earth. <i><b>Nether</b> regions.</i>
<b>place</b>	Put into a certain place or abstract location. <i>A survey <b>placed</b> the company 13th for achievement.</i>
<b>sepulcher</b>	A chamber that is used as a grave.
<b><u>situated</u></b>	Situated in a particular spot or position. <i>Nicely <b>situated</b> on a quiet riverbank.</i>
<b>subnormal</b>	A person of less than normal intelligence. <i><b>Subnormal</b> intelligence.</i>
<b><u>subterranean</u></b>	Lying beyond what is openly revealed or avowed (especially being kept in the background or deliberately concealed). <i><b>Subterranean</b> passages.</i>

- tomb** A place for the burial of a corpse especially beneath the ground and marked by a tombstone.  
*The house was as quiet as a **tomb**.*
- under** Under water.  
*The **under** parts of a machine.*
- underground** A member of an underground political group or movement.  
*An **underground** car park.*
- underneath** Situated directly below something else.  
*He was wearing a brown jacket with a white T shirt **underneath**.*
- underpass** An underground tunnel or passage enabling pedestrians to cross a road or railway.
- underside** The lower side of anything.  
*The butterfly s wings have a mottled brown pattern on the **underside**.*
