- *A long seat in Parliament for politicians of a specified party.*
- *The reserve players on a team.*
- *A long work table in a workshop or laboratory.*
- *A seat at the side of a sports field for coaches, substitutes, and players not taking part in a game.*
- *The office of judge or magistrate.*
- *A judge or magistrate presiding over a particular case.*
- *The seat for judges in a courtroom.*
- *A strong worktable for a carpenter or mechanic.*
- *A long seat for more than one person.*
- *A long seat for several people, typically made of wood or stone.*
- *A judge's seat in a law court.*
- *Persons who administer justice.*
- *The politicians occupying a specified bench in Parliament.*
- *The magistrate or judge or judges sitting in court in judicial capacity to compose the*

*court collectively.*

- *A level shelf of land interrupting a declivity (with steep slopes above and below.*
- *A flat ledge in masonry or on sloping ground.*
- *(law) the seat for judges in a courtroom.*

### [board](#)

A flat portable surface usually rectangular designed for board games.  
A **board** meeting.

### [buffet](#)

A meal set out on a buffet at which guests help themselves.  
A cold **buffet** lunch.

### [counter](#)

Game equipment (as a piece of wood, plastic, or ivory) used for keeping a count or reserving a space in various card or board games.  
The **counter** tells you how many pictures you have taken.

### **form**

A set order of words a formula.  
She seemed to be on good **form**.

<b>judges</b>	A book of the Old Testament that tells the history of Israel under the leaders known as judges.
<b>judicature</b>	The act of meting out justice according to the law. <i>The constitutional principle that the legislature is separate from the <b>judicature</b>.</i>
<b>judiciary</b>	Persons who administer justice. <i>The independence of the <b>judiciary</b>.</i>
<b>magistrates</b>	A lay judge or civil authority who administers the law (especially one who conducts a court dealing with minor offenses).
<b>pew</b>	A seat. <i>Take a <b>pew</b> What ll you have.</i>
<b>seat</b>	A thing made or used for sitting on, such as a chair or stool. <i>The brain is said to be the <b>seat</b> of reason.</i>
<b>settle</b>	A long wooden bench with a back.
<b>stall</b>	An instance of an engine vehicle aircraft or boat stalling. <i>Speed must be maintained to avoid a <b>stall</b> and loss of control.</i>
<b>table</b>	Multiplication tables. <i>He was reputed to have the finest French <b>table</b> of the time.</i>
<b>terrace</b>	A level paved area next to a building; a patio. <i>An attractive Regency <b>terrace</b>.</i>
<b>trestle table</b>	Sawhorses used in pairs to support a horizontal tabletop.
<b>work bench</b>	A manifestation of energy; the transfer of energy from one physical system to another expressed as the product of a force and the distance through which it moves a body in the direction of that force.
<b>work surface</b>	The occupation for which you are paid.
<b>workbench</b>	A flat table or surface at which carpentry or other mechanical or practical work is done.
<b>worktable</b>	A table at which one may work, especially one with drawers or compartments for holding tools or materials.

*She sat **astride** the chair.*

### auditorium

The part of a theatre, concert hall, or other public building in which the audience sits.  
*The stage was small and the **auditorium** had only 366 seats.*

### below

Below deck.  
*Our nutritionist is pictured **below** right.*

### buffer

Add a buffer a solution.  
*Print speed is boosted by pages being formatted in a **buffer** while another is printing.*

### centerpiece

The central or most important feature.  
*Education was the **centerpiece** of the Democratic Party's political platform.*

### chair

Act or preside as chair as of an academic department in a university.  
*He was awarded an endowed **chair** in economics.*

<b><u>couch</u></b>	Lower (a spear) to the position for attack. <i>Cataracts when simple are to be <b>couched</b>.</i>
<b><u>cushion</u></b>	A mechanical damper; absorbs energy of sudden impulses. <i>To <b>cushion</b> the blow wages and pensions were increased.</i>
<b>desk</b>	A counter in a hotel, bank, or airport at which a customer may check in or obtain information. <i>The reception <b>desk</b>.</i>
<b>desktop</b>	The working area of a computer screen regarded as a representation of a notional desktop and containing icons representing items such as files. <i>You can now have multiple overlapping windows on the <b>desktop</b>.</i>
<b><u>dining</u></b>	The act of eating dinner. <i>A <b>dining</b> area.</i>
<b><u>down</u></b>	Shoot at and force to come down. <i>Prices plunged <b>downward</b>.</i>
<b><u>furniture</u></b>	The small accessories or fittings that are required for a particular task or function. <i>They had too much <b>furniture</b> for the small apartment.</i>
<b><u>gym</u></b>	Gymnastics. <i>I can t do <b>gym</b> today.</i>
<b>idly</b>	In an aimless or lazy way. <i>I can no longer stand <b>idly</b> by and let him take the blame.</i>
<b>incubate</b>	(in a laboratory or other controlled situation) keep (eggs, bacteria, embryos, etc.) at a suitable temperature so that they develop. <i>The samples were <b>incubated</b> at 80 C for 3 minutes.</i>
<b><u>kitchen</u></b>	A set of fitments and units that are sold together and fixed in place in a kitchen. <i>A fully fitted <b>kitchen</b> at a bargain price.</i>
<b>locate</b>	Take up residence and become established. <i>Our sense of sight enables us to <b>locate</b> objects in space.</i>
<b>nestle</b>	Position comfortably. <i>The baby <b>nestled</b> her head in her mother s elbow.</i>
<b><u>park</u></b>	Maneuver a vehicle into a parking space. <i>Can you <b>park</b> right here.</i>
<b>proscenium</b>	The part of a theatre stage in front of the curtain.
<b>recliner</b>	A chair with a reclining back, especially one with an integral footrest.
<b>seat</b>	Be able to seat. <i>The mother <b>seated</b> the toddler on the high chair.</i>



**sit**

Be or remain in a particular position or state.

*The fridge was **sitting** in a pool of water.*

**sofa**

A long upholstered seat with a back and arms, for two or more people.

***Sofa** cushions.*

**stool**

Lure with a stool as of wild fowl.

*Concentrations of the substance in normal **stool**.*

**table**

A list of rivals or competitors showing their positions relative to one another a league table.

*She sets a fine **table**.*

**tensile**

Relating to tension.

*A **tensile** force.*

**terrace**

Provide a house with a terrace.

*Breakfast is served on the **terrace**.*

**workbench** A strong worktable for a carpenter or mechanic.
