- A seat at the side of a sports field for coaches, substitutes, and players not taking part in a game.
- The office of judge or magistrate.
- A judge or magistrate presiding over a particular case.
- The seat for judges in a courtroom.
- A strong worktable for a carpenter or mechanic.
- A long seat for more than one person.
- A long seat for several people, typically made of wood or stone.
- A judge's seat in a law court.
- Persons who administer justice.
- The politicians occupying a specified bench in Parliament.
- The magistrate or judge or judges sitting in court in judicial capacity to compose the



court collectively.

- A level shelf of land interrupting a declivity (with steep slopes above and below.
- A flat ledge in masonry or on sloping ground.
- (law) the seat for judges in a courtroom.
