The Forms of Benefit

Infinitive	to benefit
Present Tense	benefit / benefits
Past Tense	benefited or benefitted
Present Participle	benefiting or benefitting
Past Participle	benefited or benefitted

Conjugate Benefit

Benefit in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I benefit	We benefit
You benefit	You benefit
He/She/It benefits	They benefit

Benefit in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am benefiting or benefitting	We are benefiting or benefitting
You are benefiting or benefitting	You are benefiting or benefitting
He/She/It is benefiting or benefitting	They are benefiting or benefitting

Benefit in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have benefited or benefitted	We have benefited or benefitted
You have benefited or benefitted	You have benefited or benefitted
He/She/It has benefited or benefitted	They have benefited or benefitted

Benefit in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been benefiting or benefitting	We have been benefiting or benefitting
You have been benefiting or benefitting	You have been benefiting or benefitting
He/She/It has been benefiting or benefitting	They have been benefiting or benefitting

Benefit in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I benefited or benefitted	We benefited or benefitted
You benefited or benefitted	You benefited or benefitted
He/She/It benefited or benefitted	They benefited or benefitted



Benefit in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I was benefiting or benefitting	We were benefiting or benefitting
You were benefiting or benefitting	You were benefiting or benefitting
He/She/It was benefiting or benefitting	They were benefiting or benefitting

Benefit in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had benefited or benefitted	We had benefited or benefitted
You had benefited or benefitted	You had benefited or benefitted
He/She/It had benefited or benefitted	l They had benefited or benefitted

Benefit in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been benefiting or benefitting	We had been benefiting or benefitting
You had been benefiting or benefitting	You had been benefiting or benefitting
He/She/It had been benefiting or benefitting	They had been benefiting or benefitting

Benefit in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will benefit	We will benefit
You will benefit	You will benefit
He/She/It will benefit	They will benefit

Benefit in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be benefiting or benefitting	We will be benefiting or benefitting
You will be benefiting or benefitting	You will be benefiting or benefitting
He/She/It will be benefiting or benefitting They will be benefiting or benefitting	



Benefit in Future Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I will have benefited or benefitted	We will have benefited or benefitted
You will have benefited or benefitted	You will have benefited or benefitted
He/She/It will have benefited or benefitted	I They will have benefited or benefitted

I will have been benefiting or benefitting	We will have been benefiting or benefitting
You will have been benefiting or	You will have been benefiting or
benefitting	benefitting
He/She/It will have been benefiting or	They will have been benefiting or
benefitting	benefitting
