Definitions of "Bereaved" as an adjective

According to the Oxford Dictionary of English, "bereaved" as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- Sorrowful through loss or deprivation.
- Deprived of a close relation or friend through their death.





Synonyms of "Bereaved" as an adjective (7 Words)

(of a person) sad and lonely, especially through someone's death or

bereft

Bereft of hope.

grief-stricken Sorrowful through loss or deprivation.

grieving Sorrowful through loss or deprivation.

mourning Sorrowful through loss or deprivation.

orphaned Deprived of parents by death or desertion.

Sorrowful through loss or deprivation. sorrowing

The **sorrowing** widower found it hard to relate to his sons.

Having lost one's spouse by death and not married again. widowed

Her widowed mother.
