### **Definitions of "Bereaved" as an adjective**

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "bereaved" as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Sorrowful through loss or deprivation.*
- *Deprived of a close relation or friend through their death.*



## Synonyms of "Bereaved" as an adjective (7 Words)

<b><u>bereft</u></b>	(of a person) sad and lonely, especially through someone's death or departure. <i><b>Bereft</b> of hope.</i>
<b><u>grief-stricken</u></b>	Sorrowful through loss or deprivation.
<b><u>grieving</u></b>	Sorrowful through loss or deprivation.
<b><u>mourning</u></b>	Sorrowful through loss or deprivation.
<b><u>orphaned</u></b>	Deprived of parents by death or desertion.
<b><u>sorrowing</u></b>	Sorrowful through loss or deprivation. <i>The <b>sorrowing</b> widower found it hard to relate to his sons.</i>
<b><u>widowed</u></b>	Having lost one's spouse by death and not married again. <i>Her <b>widowed</b> mother.</i>
