Definitions of "Bereaved" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "bereaved" as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Sorrowful through loss or deprivation.*
- *Deprived of a close relation or friend through their death.*



Synonyms of "Bereaved" as an adjective (7 Words)

<u>bereft</u>	(of a person) sad and lonely, especially through someone's death or departure. <i>Bereft of hope.</i>
<u>grief-stricken</u>	Sorrowful through loss or deprivation.
<u>grieving</u>	Sorrowful through loss or deprivation.
<u>mourning</u>	Sorrowful through loss or deprivation.
<u>orphaned</u>	Deprived of parents by death or desertion.
<u>sorrowing</u>	Sorrowful through loss or deprivation. <i>The sorrowing widower found it hard to relate to his sons.</i>
<u>widowed</u>	Having lost one's spouse by death and not married again. <i>Her widowed mother.</i>
