## **Beverage as a Noun**

### **Definitions of "Beverage" as a noun**

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “beverage” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *Any liquid suitable for drinking.*
- *(chiefly in commercial use) a drink other than water.*



### Synonyms of "Beverage" as a noun (3 Words)

**drink** The act of drinking alcoholic beverages to excess.  
*A table covered with food and **drink**.*

**drinkable** Any liquid suitable for drinking.

**potable** Any liquid suitable for drinking.

## Associations of "Beverage" (30 Words)

- cocktail** A dish consisting of small pieces of food, typically served cold as a starter.  
*A **cocktail** of drugs with severe side effects.*
- coffee** A beverage consisting of an infusion of ground coffee beans.  
*A cup of **coffee**.*
- cola** A brown carbonated drink that is flavoured with an extract of cola nuts or with a similar flavouring.  
*A warm can of **cola**.*
- drink** Any liquid suitable for drinking.  
*Let s **drink** to the New Year.*
- drinking** The act of drinking alcoholic beverages to excess.  
*He was ordered to cut down his **drinking**.*
- foodstuff** A substance suitable for consumption as food.  
*The people depend on sago starch as a basic **foodstuff**.*

<b>gin</b>	Separate the seeds from cotton with a cotton gin. <i><b>Gin</b> game.</i>
<b>gulp</b>	An act of gulping food or drink. <i>She finished her drink in one <b>gulp</b>.</i>
<b>guzzle</b>	Eat or drink (something) greedily. <i>This car <b>guzzles</b> petrol.</i>
<b>honey</b>	Of something having the color of honey. <i>Her <b>honey</b> skin.</i>
<b>imbibe</b>	Drink (alcohol). <i>If one does not <b>imbibe</b> the culture one cannot succeed.</i>
<b>juice</b>	Extract the juice from fruit or vegetables. <i>The batteries have run out of <b>juice</b>.</i>
<b>kava</b>	The shrub from which the kava root is obtained grown in the Pacific Islands.
<b>lemon</b>	A distinctive tart flavor characteristic of lemons. <i>Garnish with a slice of <b>lemon</b>.</i>
<b>lemonade</b>	A drink made from lemon juice and water sweetened with sugar. <i>A jug of <b>lemonade</b>.</i>
<b>liqueur</b>	A chocolate with a liqueur filling. <i>An Italian almond flavoured <b>liqueur</b>.</i>
<b>mead</b>	An alcoholic drink of fermented honey and water. <i>The tavern stocks beer cider perry and <b>mead</b>.</i>
<b>nip</b>	A small sharp bite or snip. <i>The vegetable garden <b>nipped</b> now by frost.</i>
<b>pop</b>	Heat popcorn or another foodstuff until it bursts open. <i>The farm <b>popped</b> into view as we turned the corner.</i>
<b>potable</b>	Suitable for drinking. <i>There is no supply of <b>potable</b> water available.</i>
<b>quaff</b>	To swallow hurriedly or greedily or in one draught. <i>Porter is a dark malty <b>quaff</b>.</i>
<b>savor</b>	Give taste to. <i><b>Savor</b> the soup.</i>
<b>sip</b>	Drink in sips. <i>She was <b>sipping</b> her tea.</i>
<b>soda</b>	A sodium salt of carbonic acid; used in making soap powders and glass and paper. <i>A can of <b>soda</b>.</i>

- sugar** Spread a mixture of sugar treacle beer etc on a tree trunk in order to catch moths.  
*A spoonful of **sugar**.*
- sweeten** Make sweeter, more pleasant, or more agreeable.  
*I am in the process of **sweetening** him up.*
- tang** The projection on the blade of a tool such as a knife, by which the blade is held firmly in the handle.  
*His words came out with a distinct **tang** of broad Lancashire.*
- tea** The evergreen shrub or small tree which produces tea leaves native to southern and eastern Asia and grown as a major cash crop.  
***Tea** bags containing **teas** from selected estates.*
- tonic** Music the first note of a diatonic scale.  
*Being needed is a **tonic** for someone at my age.*
- vino** Fermented juice (of grapes especially).
