abundant	Having plenty of. <i>An abundant supply of water.</i>

affluent	An affluent person a person who is financially well off. <i>An affluent banker.</i>
bountifulness	The property of copious abundance.
bounty	Payment or reward (especially from a government) for acts such as catching criminals or killing predatory animals or enlisting in the military. <i>There was an increased bounty on his head.</i>
considerably	To a great extent or degree. <i>Painting the room white made it seem considerably or substantially larger.</i>
cornucopia	The property of being extremely abundant. <i>The festival offers a cornucopia of pleasures.</i>
ecological	Of or relating to the science of ecology. <i>An ecological disaster.</i>
ecosystem	A biological community of interacting organisms and their physical environment. <i>The entire ecosystem of film and video production will eventually go digital.</i>
fecundation	Making fertile as by applying fertilizer or manure.

fertility	The state of being fertile; capable of producing offspring. <i>Improve the soil fertility by adding compost.</i>
land	Bring a fish to land with a net or rod. <i>He leapt over the fence and landed nimbly on his feet.</i>
lot	A plot of land assigned for sale or for a particular use. <i>It s just one lot of rich people stealing from another.</i>
magnificence	The quality of being magnificent or splendid or grand. <i>The magnificence of the surrounding countryside.</i>
many	The majority of people. <i>A good many.</i>
marine	Relating to shipping or naval matters. <i>Marine painters.</i>
mellowness	A soft shade of a color. <i>A mellowness of light and shade not attainable in marble.</i>
overflow	Overflow with a certain feeling. <i>An overflow of sewage.</i>
plenitude	An abundance. <i>The plenitude of the Pope s powers.</i>
plentitude	A full supply.

profusion	The property of being extremely abundant. <i>A rich profusion of flowers.</i>
prosper	Make steady progress; be at the high point in one’s career or reach a high point in historical significance or importance. <i>The state hopes to prosper from free trade with the United States.</i>
prosperity	An economic state of growth with rising profits and full employment. <i>A long period of peace and prosperity.</i>
richness	The property of a sensation that is rich and pleasing. <i>Her voice retains a wonderful richness of tone.</i>
substantially	In a strong substantial way. <i>Things will remain substantially the same over the next ten years.</i>
teem	Be teeming be abuzz. <i>The plaza is teeming with undercover policemen.</i>
topsoil	The layer of soil on the surface. <i>Keep all the topsoil you remove you re bound to find a use for it later.</i>
