## Associations of "Biologically" (30 Words)

<b>affective</b>	Characterized by emotion. <i><b>Affective</b> disorders.</i>
<b>behavioral</b>	Of or relating to behavior. <i><b>Behavioral</b> sciences.</i>
<b>biology</b>	The study of living organisms, divided into many specialized fields that cover their morphology, physiology, anatomy, behaviour, origin, and distribution. <i>The <b>biology</b> of the Chesapeake Bay.</i>
<a href="#">biosphere</a>	The regions of the surface and atmosphere of the Earth (or other planet) where living organisms exist. <i>The elliptical domed <b>biosphere</b> is the largest single span glasshouse in the world.</i>
<b>character</b>	A characteristic especially one that assists in the identification of a species. <i>Shady <b>characters</b>.</i>
<b>clone</b>	Propagate an organism or cell as a clone. <i>We have <b>cloned</b> DNA sequences added to the ends of the linear plasmid.</i>
<b>genetically</b>	In a way that relates to origin or development. <i>A <b>genetically</b> inherited condition.</i>
<b>genetics</b>	The study of heredity and the variation of inherited characteristics. <i>The effects of family <b>genetics</b> on the choice of career.</i>
<b>hereditary</b>	Inherited or inheritable by established rules (usually legal rules) of descent. <i>Cystic fibrosis is our most common fatal <b>hereditary</b> disease.</i>
<b>inborn</b>	Normally existing at birth. <i>An <b>inborn</b> defect in the formation of collagen.</i>
<b>inclination</b>	An attitude of mind especially one that favors one alternative over others. <i>My inborn <b>inclination</b> for things with moving parts.</i>

<b>incline</b>	An inclined surface connecting two levels. <i>She s <b>inclined</b> to gossip with complete strangers.</i>
<b>influence</b>	Shape or influence give direction to. <i>The <b>influence</b> of mechanical action.</i>
<b>innate</b>	Inborn; natural. <i>An <b>innate</b> talent.</i>
<b>inspired</b>	(of a person) displaying a creative impulse in the activity specified. <i>She was an <b>inspired</b> gardener.</i>
<b>life</b>	An account of the series of events making up a person s life. <i>She was beautiful and full of <b>life</b>.</i>
<b>liking</b>	A feeling of regard or fondness. <i>She developed a <b>liking</b> for gin.</i>
<b>living</b>	Pertaining to living persons. <i>What does he do for a <b>living</b>.</i>
<b>neurology</b>	Neurology the branch of medicine that deals with the nervous system and its disorders.
<b>ophthalmology</b>	The branch of medicine concerned with the study and treatment of disorders and diseases of the eye.
<b>organism</b>	The material structure of an organism. <i>The Church is a divinely constituted <b>organism</b>.</i>
<b>penchant</b>	A strong liking. <i>He has a <b>penchant</b> for adopting stray dogs.</i>
<b>predilection</b>	A predisposition in favor of something. <i>A <b>predilection</b> for expensive cars.</i>
<b>predispose</b>	Make susceptible. <i>This illness <b>predisposes</b> you to gain weight.</i>
<b>predisposition</b>	Susceptibility to a pathogen. <i>Factors including genetic <b>predisposition</b>.</i>
<b>preference</b>	A predisposition in favor of something. <i>My own <b>preference</b> is for good literature.</i>
<b>savor</b>	Give taste to. <i><b>Savor</b> the soup.</i>
<b>savour</b>	The taste experience when a savoury condiment is taken into the mouth. <i>I wanted to <b>savour</b> every moment.</i>
<b>tendency</b>	An attitude of mind especially one that favors one alternative over others. <i>A <b>tendency</b> to be too strict.</i>
