## Associations of "Biosphere" (30 Words)

<b>aeronautics</b>	The science or practice of building or flying aircraft.
<b>biochemistry</b>	The processes and substances with which the science of biochemistry is concerned. <i>Abnormal brain <b>biochemistry</b>.</i>
<a href="#">biodiversity</a>	The variety of plant and animal life in the world or in a particular habitat, a high level of which is usually considered to be important and desirable. <i>A high level of <b>biodiversity</b> is desirable.</i>
<b>biology</b>	The science that studies living organisms. <i>Human <b>biology</b>.</i>
<b>biotech</b>	The branch of molecular biology that studies the use of microorganisms to perform specific industrial processes. <i><b>Biotechnology</b> produced genetically altered bacteria that solved the problem.</i>
<b>biotechnology</b>	The branch of engineering science in which biological science is used to study the relation between workers and their environments. <i><b>Biotechnology</b> produced genetically altered bacteria that solved the problem.</i>
<b>colloid</b>	Relating to or characterized by a colloid or colloids.
<a href="#">earthly</a>	Relating to humankind’s material existence as distinct from a spiritual or heavenly one. <i><b>Earthly</b> love.</i>
<a href="#">ecological</a>	Relating to or concerned with the relation of living organisms to one another and to their physical surroundings. <i>One of the world s worst <b>ecological</b> disasters.</i>
<b>ecology</b>	The branch of biology concerned with the relations between organisms and their environment. <i>It changed the <b>ecology</b> of the island.</i>

<b>ecosystem</b>	(in general use) a complex network or interconnected system. <i>Silicon Valley's entrepreneurial <b>ecosystem</b>.</i>
<b>endangered</b>	(of flora or fauna) in imminent danger of extinction. <i>An <b>endangered</b> species.</i>
<b>engineering</b>	The action of working artfully to bring something about. <i>Software <b>engineering</b>.</i>
<b>ethology</b>	The science of animal behaviour.
<b>evolution</b>	Biology the sequence of events involved in the evolutionary development of a species or taxonomic group of organisms. <i>The forms of written languages undergo constant <b>evolution</b>.</i>
<b>evolutionary</b>	Relating to a pattern of movements or manoeuvres. <i><b>Evolutionary</b> tactics.</i>
<b>life</b>	A sentence of imprisonment for life. <i>He got <b>life</b> for killing the guard.</i>
<b>mangrove</b>	A tidal swamp which is dominated by mangroves.
<b>meteorology</b>	The branch of science concerned with the processes and phenomena of the atmosphere, especially as a means of forecasting the weather. <i>Overwintering would allow the team to investigate the island's <b>meteorology</b>.</i>
<b>overland</b>	Traveling or passing over land. <i>An <b>overland</b> trade route.</i>
<b>pedagogics</b>	The principles and methods of instruction.
<b>polymer</b>	A substance which has a molecular structure built up chiefly or completely from a large number of similar units bonded together, e.g. many synthetic organic materials used as plastics and resins.
<b>science</b>	A particular area of science. <i>Veterinary <b>science</b>.</i>
<b>secular</b>	A secular priest. <i><b>Secular</b> drama.</i>
<b>seduction</b>	Enticing someone astray from right behavior. <i>The <b>seductions</b> of the mainland.</i>
<b>speciation</b>	The formation of new and distinct species in the course of evolution.
<b>temporal</b>	Characteristic of or devoted to the temporal world as opposed to the spiritual world. <i><b>Temporal</b> matters of but fleeting moment.</i>
<b>terrestrial</b>	Operating or living or growing on land. <i>Increased ultraviolet radiation may disrupt <b>terrestrial</b> ecosystems.</i>

**threatened**

(of flora or fauna) likely in the near future to become endangered.  
*The spotted owl is a **threatened** species not yet an endangered one.*

**worldly**

Of or concerned with material values or ordinary life rather than a spiritual existence.

***Worldly** goods and advancement.*
