Present Tense	bird-dog / bird-dogs
Past Tense	bird-dogged
Present Participle	bird-dogging

Conjugate Bird-dog

Bird-dog in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I bird-dog	We bird-dog
You bird-dog	You bird-dog
He/She/It bird-dogs	They bird-dog

Bird-dog in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am bird-dogging	We are bird-dogging
You are bird-dogging	You are bird-dogging
He/She/It is bird-dogging	They are bird-dogging

Bird-dog in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have bird-dogged	We have bird-dogged
You have bird-dogged	You have bird-dogged
He/She/It has bird-dogged	They have bird-dogged

Bird-dog in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been bird-dogging	We have been bird-dogging
You have been bird-dogging	You have been bird-dogging
He/She/It has been bird-dogging	They have been bird-dogging

Bird-dog in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I bird-dogged	We bird-dogged
You bird-dogged	You bird-dogged
He/She/It bird-dogged	They bird-dogged

Bird-dog in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was bird-dogging	We were bird-dogging
You were bird-dogging	You were bird-dogging
He/She/It was bird-dogging	They were bird-dogging

Bird-dog in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had bird-dogged	We had bird-dogged
You had bird-dogged	You had bird-dogged
He/She/It had bird-dogged	They had bird-dogged

Bird-dog in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been bird-dogging	We had been bird-dogging
You had been bird-dogging	You had been bird-dogging
He/She/It had been bird-dogging	They had been bird-dogging

Bird-dog in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will bird-dog	We will bird-dog
You will bird-dog	You will bird-dog
He/She/It will bird-dog	They will bird-dog

Bird-dog in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

SingularPluralI will be bird-doggingWe will be bird-doggingYou will be bird-doggingYou will be bird-doggingHe/She/It will be bird-doggingThey will be bird-dogging

Bird-dog in Future Perfect Tense



SingularPluralI will have bird-doggedWe will have bird-doggedYou will have bird-doggedYou will have bird-doggedHe/She/It will have bird-doggedThey will have bird-dogged

Singular	Plural
I will have been bird-dogging	We will have been bird-dogging
You will have been bird-dogging	You will have been bird-dogging
He/She/It will have been bird-dogging	They will have been bird-dogging
