<b><a href="#">ashen</a></b>	Of or resembling ashes. <i>A face turned <b>ashen</b>.</i>
<b>blond</b>	A person with fair skin and hair. <i><b>Blond</b> Scandinavians.</i>
<b>blue</b>	A person who has represented Cambridge University a Cambridge blue or Oxford University an Oxford blue at a particular sport in a match between the two universities. <i>Deep <b>blue</b> eyes.</i>
<b><a href="#">brown</a></b>	Brown clothes or material. <i>The draught <b>browned</b> the leaves on the trees in the yard.</i>
<b>brownish</b>	Of a color similar to that of wood or earth. <i>A <b>brownish</b> coloured cat.</i>
<b>color</b>	Change color often in an undesired manner. <i>His political ideas <b>color</b> his lectures.</i>
<b>cygnet</b>	A young swan.
<b>downcast</b>	A ventilation shaft through which air enters a mine. <i>Her modestly <b>downcast</b> eyes.</i>
<b>dun</b>	An artificial fishing fly made to resemble a dun. <i>A <b>dun</b> cow.</i>
<b>ebony</b>	Used in names of trees that produce timber similar to ebony e g Jamaican ebony or American ebony. <i>His smile flashed against the <b>ebony</b> of his skin.</i>
<b>enamel</b>	Coat or decorate a metallic or hard object with enamel. <i>White <b>enamel</b> bowls.</i>
<b>fawn</b>	Have fawns. <i>A six month old roe <b>fawn</b>.</i>

<b>gray</b>	English radiobiologist in whose honor the gray the SI unit of energy for the absorbed dose of radiation was named 1905 1965. <b>Gray</b> flannel suit.
<b>green</b>	Green vegetables. They will continue <b>greening</b> the many treeless and dusty suburbs.
<b>grey</b>	Of a person having grey hair. A <b>grey</b> area between clearly legal and strictly illegal.
<b>hue</b>	Take on color or become colored. The water is the deepest <b>hue</b> of aquamarine.
<b>ivory</b>	An object made of ivory. A dagger with an <b>ivory</b> handle.
<b>magenta</b>	A primary subtractive color for light a dark purple red color the dye for magenta was discovered in 1859 the year of the battle of Magenta. A short <b>magenta</b> dress.
<b>marbled</b>	(of meat) having the lean part streaked with thin layers of fat. Attractively <b>marbled</b> cloth or paper.
<b>maroon</b>	A brownish-red colour. Ornate <b>maroon</b> and gold wallpaper.
<b>pigmentation</b>	The natural colouring of animal or plant tissue.
<b>pink</b>	Pink colour pigment or material. Bright <b>pink</b> lipstick.
<b>purple</b>	Purple clothing or material. He was born to the <b>purple</b> .
<b>red</b>	Especially of the face reddened or suffused with or as if with blood from emotion or exertion. A glass of <b>red</b> wine.
<b>rose</b>	The flower of a rose bush. He sent her a dozen red <b>roses</b> .
<b>roseate</b>	Used in names of birds with partly pink plumage e g roseate tern. The <b>roseate</b> glow of dawn.
<b>soot</b>	Coat with soot. You have previously <b>sooted</b> the underside of their plate by holding it over a candle.
<b>tusk</b>	Remove the tusks of animals. <b>Tusk</b> an elephant.
<b>wan</b>	Lacking in intensity or brightness; dim or feeble. The <b>wan</b> dawn light.
