## Associations of "Blackened" (30 Words)

- anthracite** A hard natural coal that burns slowly and gives intense heat.  
*A wide range of colours from **anthracite** to blush pink.*
- black** Made black especially as with suffused blood.  
*My soul is steeped in the **blackest** sin.*
- briquette** A block of compressed coal dust or peat used as fuel.
- burning** The act of burning something.  
*The **burning** question of independence.*
- burnt** Treated by heating to a high temperature but below the melting or fusing point.  
*Barricaded the street with **burnt** out cars.*
- carbon** A piece of carbon paper or a carbon copy.  
*The level of **carbon** in the atmosphere has been consistently rising.*

<b>cauterize</b>	Burn, sear, or freeze (tissue) using a hot iron or electric current or a caustic agent. <i>I ll freeze the hand and <b>cauterize</b> the wound.</i>
<b>char</b>	Burn to charcoal. <i>The <b>char</b> will clean the carpet.</i>
<b>charcoal</b>	Charcoal used for drawing. <i>With a thick <b>charcoal</b> he traced out the line of the front.</i>
<b>coal</b>	Provide with a supply of coal. <i>A <b>coal</b> fire.</i>
<b>collier</b>	A ship carrying coal.
<b>colliery</b>	A workplace consisting of a coal mine plus all the buildings and equipment connected with it.
<b>darken</b>	Become dark or darker. <i>Misery <b>darkened</b> her gaze.</i>
<b>excavation</b>	The site of an archeological exploration. <i>The methods of <b>excavation</b> have to be extremely rigorous.</i>
<b>fire</b>	A fireplace in which a relatively small fire is burning. <i>I <b>fired</b> the straw.</i>
<b>flame</b>	Be in flames or aflame. <i>Jess s cheeks <b>flamed</b>.</i>
<b>gasification</b>	The process of changing into gas. <i>Coal gas is produced by the <b>gasification</b> of coal.</i>
<b>hot</b>	Make or become hot. <i>A <b>hot</b> scent.</i>
<b>miner</b>	A person who obtains units of a cryptocurrency by running computer processes to solve specific mathematical problems. <i>He worked as a <b>miner</b> at Wearmouth Colliery for 27 years.</i>
<b>mineshaft</b>	A deep narrow vertical hole, or sometimes a horizontal tunnel, that gives access to a mine. <i>One member of this party almost vanished down a hidden disused <b>mineshaft</b>.</i>
<b>mining</b>	The act of extracting ores or coal etc from the earth. <i>Coal <b>mining</b>.</i>
<b>ore</b>	A monetary subunit in Denmark and Norway and Sweden 100 ore equal 1 krona. <i>A good deposit of lead bearing <b>ores</b>.</i>
<b>parch</b>	Cause to wither or parch from exposure to heat. <i>His crops <b>parched</b> during the last two summers.</i>

- scorch** A plant disease that produces a browning or scorched appearance of plant tissues.  
*A sports car was **scorching** along the expressway.*
- scurry** A situation of hurried and confused movement.  
*The sled disappeared in a **scurry** of snow.*
- sear** Make very hot and dry.  
***Sear** the chicken livers in a pan for a few minutes on each side.*
- singe** A surface burn.  
*The fire had **singed** his eyebrows.*
- soot** Coat with soot.  
*You have previously **sooted** the underside of their plate by holding it over a candle.*
- swarthy** Naturally having skin of a dark color.  
***Swarthy** men with gleaming teeth.*
- tan** Convert animal skin into leather by soaking in a liquid containing tannic acid or by the use of other chemicals.  
*Jenna managed to get an even golden **tan**.*
