Present Tense	blackjack / blackjacks
Past Tense	blackjacked
Present Participle	blackjacking
Past Participle	blackjacked

# **Conjugate Blackjack**

## **Blackjack in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>blackjack</b>	We <b>blackjack</b>
You <b>blackjack</b>	You <b>blackjack</b>
He/She/It <b>blackjacks</b>	They <b>blackjack</b>

## **Blackjack in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am blackjacking	We are blackjacking
You <b>are blackjacking</b>	You <b>are blackjacking</b>
He/She/It is blackjacking	They are blackjacking

## **Blackjack in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have blackjacked	We have blackjacked
You <b>have blackjacked</b>	You have blackjacked
He/She/It has blackjacked	They have blackjacked

## **Blackjack in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been blackjacking	We <b>have been blackjacking</b>
You <b>have been blackjacking</b>	You <b>have been blackjacking</b>
He/She/It has been blackjacking	They have been blackjacking

## **Blackjack in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I blackjacked	We <b>blackjacked</b>
You <b>blackjacked</b>	You <b>blackjacked</b>
He/She/It <b>blackjacked</b>	They <b>blackjacked</b>

#### **Blackjack in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was blackjacking	We <b>were blackjacking</b>
You <b>were blackjacking</b>	You <b>were blackjacking</b>
He/She/It was blackjacking	They were blackjacking

## **Blackjack in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had blackjacked	We had blackjacked
You <b>had blackjacked</b>	You <b>had blackjacked</b>
He/She/It had blackjacked	They had blackjacked

## **Blackjack in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been blackjacking	We <b>had been blackjacking</b>
You <b>had been blackjacking</b>	You <b>had been blackjacking</b>
He/She/It had been blackjacking	They had been blackjacking

## **Blackjack in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will blackjack	We <b>will blackjack</b>
You <b>will blackjack</b>	You <b>will blackjack</b>
He/She/It will blackjack	They <b>will blackjack</b>

## **Blackjack in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be blackjacking	We <b>will be blackjacking</b>
You <b>will be blackjacking</b>	You <b>will be blackjacking</b>
He/She/It will be blackjacking	They will be blackjacking

## **Blackjack in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have blackjackedWe will have blackjackedYou will have blackjackedYou will have blackjackedHe/She/It will have blackjackeeThey will have blackjackee

## **Blackjack in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been blackjacking	We <b>will have been blackjacking</b>
You <b>will have been blackjacking</b>	You <b>will have been blackjacking</b>
He/She/It will have been blackjacking	They will have been blackjacking
