## **Blacklist as a Noun**

### **Definitions of "Blacklist" as a noun**

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “blacklist” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A list of people who are out of favor.*
- *A list of people or things that are regarded as unacceptable or untrustworthy and should be excluded or avoided.*



## Synonyms of "Blacklist" as a noun (2 Words)

**black book** The quality or state of the achromatic color of least lightness (bearing the least resemblance to white).

**shitlist** A list of people who are out of favor.  
*He was unaware of how deeply he had plunged on her **shitlist**.*



## Usage Examples of "Blacklist" as a noun

- *A blacklist of blocked websites.*
- *He was placed on a blacklist which meant he was unable to get credit.*

## Blacklist as a Verb

### Definitions of "Blacklist" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "blacklist" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Put on a blacklist.*
- *Put on a blacklist so as to banish or cause to be boycotted.*



## Synonyms of "Blacklist" as a verb (9 Words)

<b>avoid</b>	Repudiate, nullify, or render void (a decree or contract). <i>Book early to <b>avoid</b> disappointment.</i>
<b><u>boycott</u></b>	Withdraw from commercial or social relations with (a country, organization, or person) as a punishment or protest. <i>We will <b>boycott</b> all banks which take part in the loans scheme.</i>
<b>consider undesirable</b>	Look at attentively.
<b><u>embargo</u></b>	Prevent commerce. <i><b>Embargoed</b> publications.</i>
<b>ignore</b>	Bar from attention or consideration. <i>He <b>ignored</b> her outraged question.</i>
<b><u>ostracize</u></b>	Avoid speaking to or dealing with. <i>Ever since I spoke up my colleagues <b>ostracize</b> me.</i>
<b>place an embargo on</b>	Take a place in a competition; often followed by an ordinal.
<b>put an embargo on</b>	Put into a certain place or abstract location.
<b>steer clear of</b>	Direct (oneself) somewhere.

## Usage Examples of "Blacklist" as a verb

- *Workers were blacklisted after being quoted in the newspaper.*
- *Many books were blacklisted by the Nazis.*
- *Blacklisted books.*
