Infinitive	to blamestorm
Present Tense	blamestorm / blamestorms
Past Tense	blamestormed
Present Participle	blamestorming
Past Participle	blamestormed

# **Conjugate Blamestorm**

## **Blamestorm in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I blamestorm	We <b>blamestorm</b>
You <b>blamestorm</b>	You <b>blamestorm</b>
He/She/It <b>blamestorms</b>	They <b>blamestorm</b>

## **Blamestorm in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am blamestorming	We <b>are blamestorming</b>
You <b>are blamestorming</b>	You <b>are blamestorming</b>
He/She/It is blamestorming	They <b>are blamestorming</b>

#### **Blamestorm in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have blamestormed	We have blamestormed
You have blamestormed	You have blamestormed
He/She/It has blamestormed	They have blamestormed

### **Blamestorm in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been blamestorming	We have been blamestorming
You have been blamestorming	You have been blamestorming
He/She/It has been blamestorming	They have been blamestorming

## **Blamestorm in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I blamestormed	We <b>blamestormed</b>
You <b>blamestormed</b>	You <b>blamestormed</b>
He/She/It <b>blamestormed</b>	They <b>blamestormed</b>

#### **Blamestorm in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was blamestorming	We were blamestorming
You were blamestorming	You were blamestorming
He/She/It was blamestorming	They were blamestorming

#### **Blamestorm in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had blamestormed	We had blamestormed
You had blamestormed	You had blamestormed
He/She/It had blamestormed	They had blamestormed

#### **Blamestorm in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been blamestorming	We had been blamestorming
You had been blamestorming	You had been blamestorming
He/She/It had been blamestorming	They had been blamestorming

## **Blamestorm in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will blamestorm	We will blamestorm
You will blamestorm	You <b>will blamestorm</b>
He/She/It will blamestorm	They will blamestorm

## **Blamestorm in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be blamestorming	We <b>will be blamestorming</b>
You <b>will be blamestorming</b>	You will be blamestorming
He/She/It will be blamestorming	They will be blamestorming

#### **Blamestorm in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular	Plural
I will have blamestormed	We will have blamestormed
You <b>will have blamestormed</b>	You will have blamestormed
He/She/It will have blamestormed	They will have blamestormed

## **Blamestorm in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been blamestorming	We will have been blamestorming
You <b>will have been blamestorming</b>	You will have been blamestorming
He/She/It will have been blamestorming	They will have been blamestorming
